

Wisdom - Academic Week reveals Rosarians' pursuit for wisdom!

Academic Week is partly held in semester one and partly held in semester two. The event encourages students to learn outside the classroom through different academic activities. Booths, stall games and activities are designed to educate and motivate students' interest in learning in an enjoyable and relaxed setting.
