

## **25<sup>th</sup> Students' Top Ten News Election**

Congratulations to our students for their excellent performance in the 25<sup>th</sup> Students' Top Ten News Election organized by the Hok Yau Club. The event aims to enhance secondary pupils' civic awareness and critical thinking.

It was an interdepartmental collaboration among the Liberal Studies Department, English Department, Chinese Department, Integrated Humanities Department, Geography Department and History Department. Our concerted effort has successfully motivated almost all of our students to participate in different competitions in this event, namely (a) News Writing for the Top Ten News Election (First Round); (b) Project Learning Competition; (c) News Commentary Competition; and (d) Top Ten News Election (Final Round).

Our S5A students (Jasveen, Chelsea, Issabelle, Stephanie) won the Merit Prize in the Project Learning Competition. Whereas, Alexandra of S3A won the 2<sup>nd</sup> runner up (Junior Division) and Andre of S5B won Merit Prize (Senior Division) in the English News Commentary Competition. Finally, our school's enthusiastic participation was awarded the Golden Award in the overall performance as we were one of the three Best Performing schools among 145 participating secondary schools.
