

Excellent Performance in Moot Court Competition attracts Camera Shoots of different Newspaper

The Liberal Studies Department has participated in Teen Talk organized by the Law Society of Hong Kong for 6 consecutive years with the participation of over 220 senior-form students. This year, Rosaryhill School arranged 3 student teams to participate in the Moot Court competition which was held in the University of Hong Kong on 12 November 2016. Students got a chance to play different characters in a courtroom like defense lawyer, prosecutor, witnesses and defendant. Our students performed exceptionally well. WONG KA YUK of S4D and GURUNG STEPHANIE VILLAEBE of S5A were selected as the Best Witnesses whereas SUBANG DANIELLE PALAGANAS of 5A was selected as the Best Prosecutor. Their outstanding performance successfully attracted the camera shoots of different newspapers including Mingpao A17 (22 November 2016) and The Standard (18 November 2016). Teen Talk is just one example of how Rosaryhill School remains committed to providing its students with diverse and challenging learning experiences that enable students to explore and expand their potential.

In fact, we have provided a lot of outside classroom learning activities for our students to learn the concept of the rule of law.
