


Inspired teaching must supply an inclination to travel the unknown. Turning points must be reached. Choices must be made. And always, these choices must be in the name of Truth and Beauty.



"Theatre in Education"

"Theatre in Education" aims at providing the students some basic theatre knowledge in running drama performances in



school. It also upgrades the stage facilities in the covered playground. 50 students from Primary 3 to Primary 6 have been enrolled in the Drama Club and they have acted out two plays in December and July already.

School Life

"A Visit to Kam Tin Heritage Trail

It is a thematic subject integration activity under the collaboration of 4 Departments, namely Chinese Language Department, History Department, Art Department and Geography Department. The rationale behind the activity is that students will find learning meaningful if things to be learnt are related to each other and to what they already know. More important, they will learn how to learn.





The field trip to the local heritage in November was the highlight of the activity. Through the observation, collaboration, inquiry and investigation made in the field trip, students took an active role in their own learning process. After several months of hard work, the winning entries of various competitions were displayed in the Internal Expo which was held in February in the School Hall. The internal Expo attracted many students, parents, teachers and teachers from other schools to share the success of the project.

A Voyage to the Moon

"A Voyage to the Moon" is a two- year language learning project with "the essence of Language as substance, Art as supplement". It aims to promote language skills through interactive artistic activities such as drama performance, choral speaking, etc.

"Legend of the Sun" was the first phase of the project whereas "Apollo I" the second phase. Students were provided an opportunity to upgrade their language skills by different means of media such as through the practice of an imaginative classic Chinese poem, drama



training by expertise,

demonstration, English play, thematic workshops stimulating creativity and critical thinking, etc. All the programmes were both instructive and entertaining. The two variety shows which were held in December and June were a big success as everyone experienced the fun of learning language in a lively, artistic and supportive environment.

They were displayed in the Third Quality Education Fund Projects Exposition, which was held in the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (Old Wing) from 9 March to 12 March. In the Expo, our student ambassadors and teachers enthusiastically explained our projects to the public. We feachers also took this opportunity to share experiences and exchange views with other teachers and educationalists. Students, parents and teachers all took pride in our QEF projects.

The highlight of the music activity was the inter-class Singh Contest. In this competition, our students learnt how to sha their opinions and talents with others.







A "Classroom Cleanliness Campaign" was held during the first term to nurture in the students the idea that they have to protect the school environment by keeping it clean and neat.

Summary of Principal's Address



Father Francisco started his address by welcoming the millennium. He went on to introduce our Guest of Honour, Mr. Matthew Chen, by outlining his distinguished achievements in Linguistics. Professor Chen's presence, in Father's words, "makes us aware of the importance that learning of languages, and the study of the social and art subjects has in the development of our society".

Father stated that there were a lot of important changes in the last school year. First, Secondary 1 to 3 classes became co-educational. Second, last school year was also the second stage in the change of medium of instruction. He said, even facing drastic changes, "the performance of our teachers and students and the results of their daily work are very satisfactory, illustrating that we are moving in the right direction".

Father was glad to see awesome improvement in public exams and the brilliant performance in interschool competitions and social services. The learning activities outside classroom, such as visiting the museums, parks and ancient pavilions, also proved to be educationally successful. Cross curriculum projects made students interested in their studies. He took this opportunity to praise the hard work of all leachers and students.

Father particularly pointed out the achievements of the walkathon 2000 and the plan of reducing classes and students. The former enabled us to raise fund for installing new computers, while the latter provided our students a better learning atmosphere.

Lastly, Father once again expressed he was proud of teachers and he congratulated prize-winners and their parents.





Summary of the Guest of Honour's Speech



Professor Chen, Dean of the Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences and Professor of Linguistics of the City University of Hong Kong, who in the past was closely related to our school, was our Guest of Honour of the 2000-2001 Prize-Giving Day.

"Hong Kong schools and universities are designed and equipped to produce well-trained professionals in all fields, and they do an admirable job of turning out teachers, civil servants, engineers, computer programmers, accountants and so forth. This is the "bread and butter" of the education establishment," said Professor Chen. "But, "Man shall not live by bread alone" (St. Luke 4:4). Nor does training equate education." Professor Chen furthered this point, explaining, "One could be well-trained for his job, if he possessed the task-specific expertise, the technical know-how." "But good education means more than that: it means critical and creative thinking, problem solving - above all, intellectual curiosity and an expanded mental horizon." In short, Professor Chen encouraged all of us to have an all-round development and a sense of comittment to life-long learning.










Drama & Debate



Parting is unavoidable. Wish all graduates a bright future!






PTA Activities
