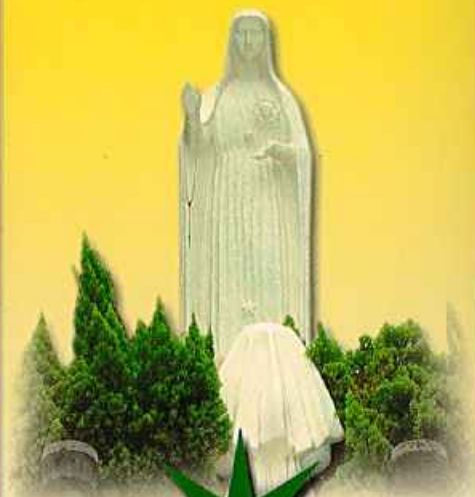



The New School Constitution

The New School Constition

Our School Constitution has passed its silver jubilee. Within the past 25 years, except for a few minor revisions, our School Constitution has remained unchanged.

Given its democratic flavor following the democratic tradition of the Dominican Order, our School Constitution has been a kind of anchor, a framework wherein the management of the School has tried to perform its duties and from where all major decisions have been derived.

The "FATHERS' COUNCIL" is the highest body in the organizational structure of the School. People familiar with the operations of ROSARYHILL know well the role that this body has played in the management of the School since its foundation. For almost 45 years of RHS existence, the FATHER'S COUNCIL, chaired by the Supervisor of the School, has played multiple roles of running the School as its real and effective Management Committee as well as acting as representative of the Sponsoring Body to government and external agencies.

All the Fathers assigned to work in the School belonged to the FATHERS' COUNCIL, regardless of their administrative position. This wider membership gave to the top management of the School a better and more comprehensive spectrum of opinions, and better quality of decisions as all major decisions were taken by a democratic voting system.

The managerial success of the past is not a guarantee of the future. Every time-honored institution undergoes "erosions" wrought by time itself. The world educational climate, the latest scientific research findings and breakthroughs, the ever changing demands of society, the development of new educational systems, the changes in the School itself plus the fact that fewer Fathers now work in the

School - all these circumstances demand a serious attempt to overhaul our School Constitution. The role of the FATHERS' COUNCIL in the future set up of the School needs careful evaluation.

Basically the draft of the New School Constitution that is under study tries to maintain the main characteristics of the current one. What is being introduced is a way of reinforcing the decision making process by making the management more accountable, more flexible, more knowledgeable, more experienced, more professional. We certainly expect the New Constitution to inspire and energize all the educational activities of the School. To face future educational challenges, we need a more open school, more responsive to the changing needs of the students, closer to the parents and the rest of society. In order to achieve these objectives, representatives from parents, teachers and the alumni will sit on the future Management of the School.

The new Constitution contemplates to maintain the body of "FATHERS' COUNCIL" but its role will be more like a supervisory body for all the educational activities of the School, rather than to perform so many executive duties as in the past. The Management of the School will perform most of those duties that in the past were performed by the FATHERS' COUNCIL alone.

We pray that all these management changes bring the beneficial results envisioned. We pray that in writing and implementing the new Constitution, we all become better instruments of peace, love, and joy in this educational life.

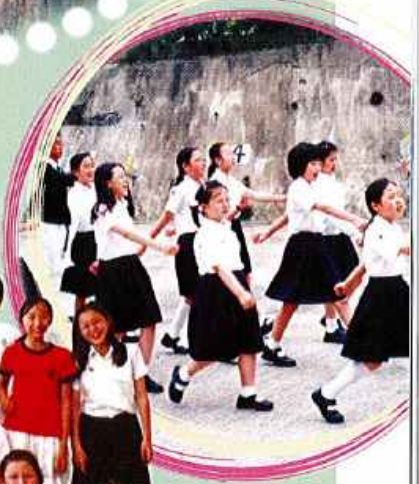
Red Cross (JU 19)

He felt pleased to repeat what he says every year-we have a wonderful team bringing stupendous results!

Father Francisco concluded his speech giving heartfelt thanks to God for His constant care and guidance in our work of education here at RHS.

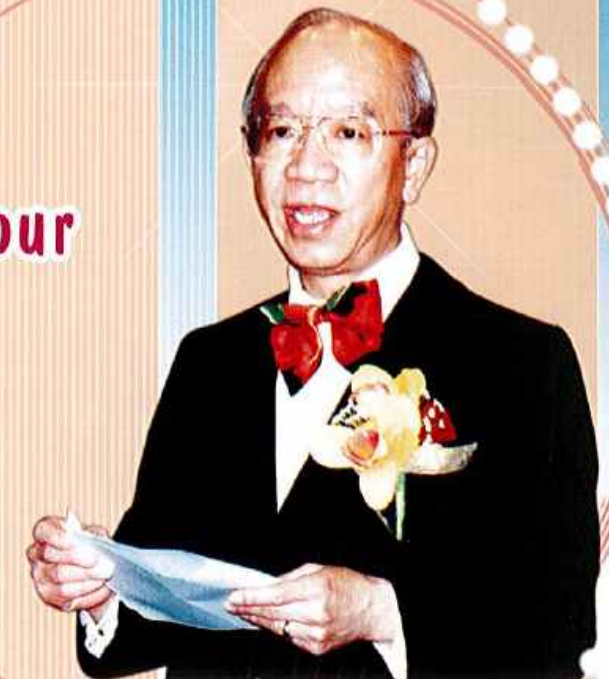


Summary of Speech of the Guest of Honour

經過數小時的車程，考察團終於抵達了目的地——廣州。廣州舊稱羊城，而南越王墓是廣州最古老的遺跡，距今已有兩千多年的歷史。學生置身古墓墓室，能夠近距離接觸古物及一睹古代墓穴的建築規模，均覺大開眼界。其後，考察團前往五層樓參觀。五層樓又名鎮海樓，是廣州著名的古建築，古時此樓用作防禦外敵，現在則改為廣州博物館。館內不但展出了年代久遠的古工藝品，更有清末民初的各種工業產品，如收音機、雪櫃及織布機，均能反映廣州文化的演進過程。稍後，考察團又往中山紀念堂參觀。紀念堂有七十多年歷史，原址為民國時孫中山先生所建的總統府。紀錄堂側的資料館陳列了不少國父的照片及書信稿件，是孫中山先生從事革命的真實寫照。

第二天，考察團到陳家祠。陳家祠建於光緒年間，是當代廣東省七十二縣陳姓人氏合資而建成的祠堂，專供本族讀書人前往廣州應考科舉時居住，故又稱陳氏書院。全院最具特色之處是其雕刻藝術，院內外的牆壁、欄杆，甚至屋頂都是市雕刻品。同學細意觀賞中國傳統建築藝術之精華後，繼而乘坐廣州地下鐵路，往烈士陵園參觀。

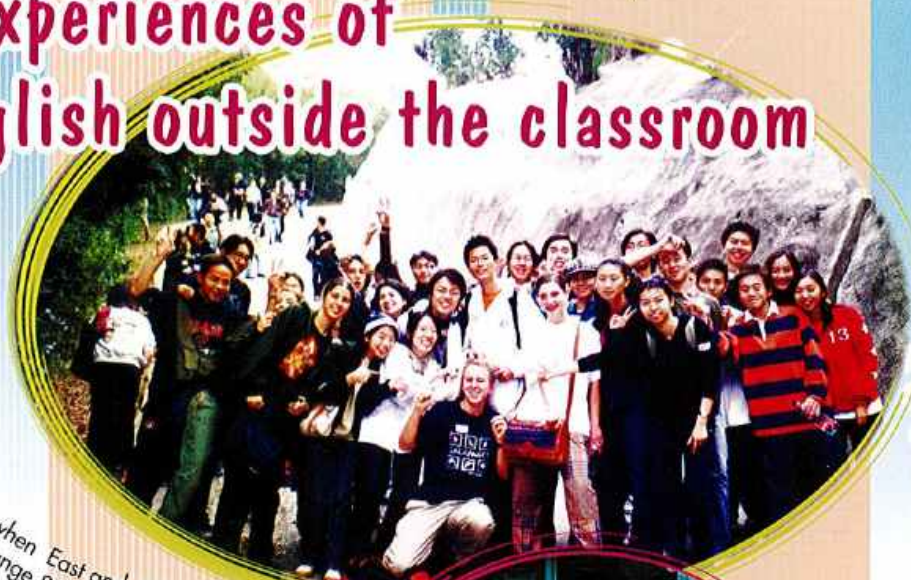
同學們均認為是次羊城文化之旅程不但令他們對內地的同學有進一步的了解，更加增進了他們對廣州文化及歷史的認識。

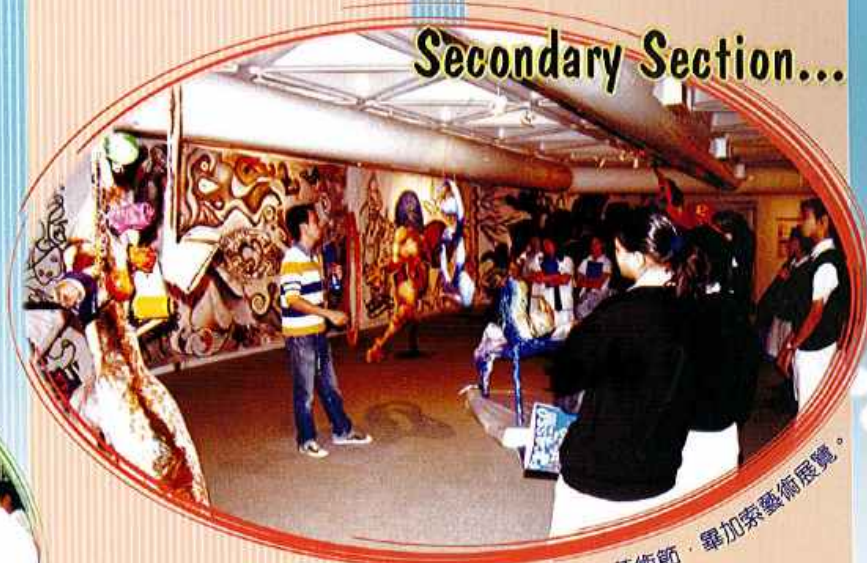

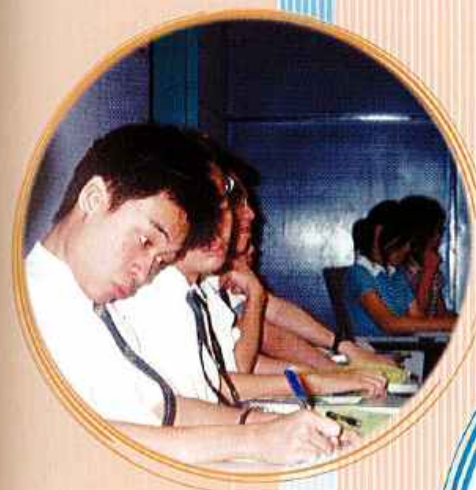
Joint-school Project Learning Experience-sharing Seminar

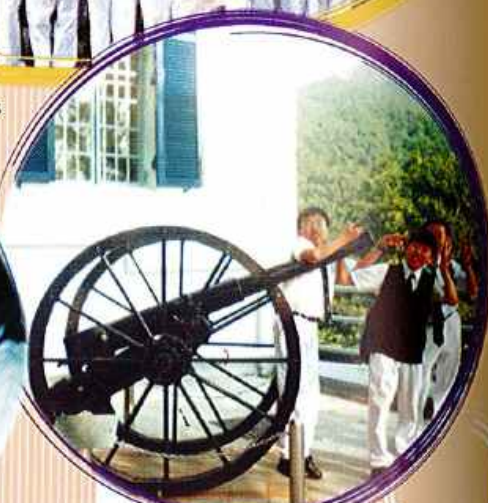

'Hi! Nice to meet you,' my host father, Chris, greeted. The greeting was the beginning of my 3-week home stay tour in Brisbane, Australia.

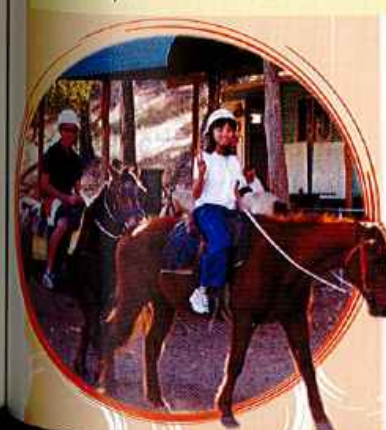
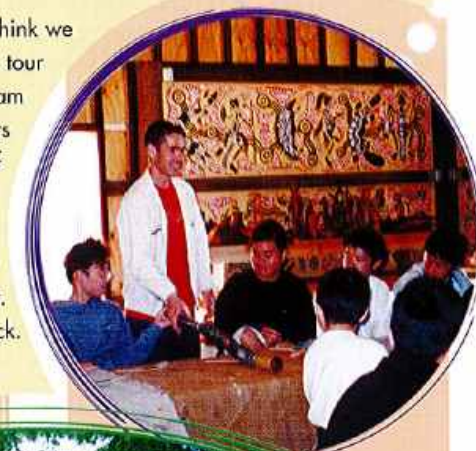
This summer, I joined the summer language stay tour with 37 schoolmates. Ms. Irene Yung and Ms. Betty Hung from our school came with us as our leaders.

Swimming Gala

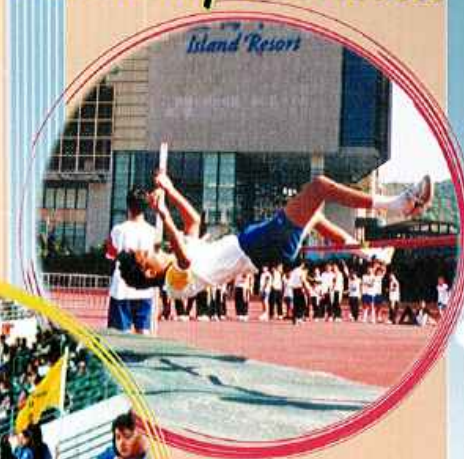
