

English Activities






The English Department has launched a couple of activities since last October to promote







We were sad to leave Disneyland.



What made the day more extraordinary was a cutting-cake ceremony after all the performances. We all said Happy Birthday to our ten-year-old Prize Giving Day!





Students learn and improve their language proficiency using installed English learning software in the Computer Centre and e-class at home.




Wonderful Orienteering Experience at Posaryhill






Art Club

中四甲 陳俊豪

四月的香港沒有出現春天的希望和生機,反而是一片悲傷、恐懼、焦慮和不安。

「喂?你是不是陳俊豪呀!……」電話简傳來熟悉的聲音——是我的班主任。雖然只是幾句的簡單的問候,裏面却包含了無限的關懷和愛心,撫平了我心的傷口,也驅散了我心頭的 愁雲慘霧。

停課以來,我心沒有一天是開懷的。天天都困在家裏,心也像被困一樣,落落寡歡起來。為甚麼世界好像眨眼間變得混亂起來?伊拉克的戰火,香港受到非典型肺炎的侵襲,張國榮的逝世,為甚麼不好的事總愛接二連三地發生?只是短短的幾天裏,突然對「人生無常,世事多變」這八個大字感受良多。誰會想到一代的巨星也會自尋短見?誰會想到香港疲弱不堪的經濟還會遇上SARS,令經濟雪上加霜?香港的天好像一下子塌了下來,令人不敢想香港的將來,繁華的夜景還會繼續璀璨下去嗎?這一切真的令人吃不消,心靈壓力去到一下子超負荷的地步。我是不是應該大哭出來?「不行。」我對自己說。香港在這個時候更需要歡笑,我應該大笑,開懷大笑,但我無論怎嘗試「歡笑」,都只不過是強顏歡笑,那些不開心的事仍萦繞心頭,揮之不去。我覺得世界上的希望都好像消失了,眼前是一片漆黑。但是在我心靈快要乾時,覺得萬念俱灰時,班主任的幾句問候,使我心靈再滋潤起來,而醫護人員在前線不屈不撓地作戰,重燃了我對香港,對未來的希望。


我曾經在電視上看到很感人的一幕:一位抗炎的醫生,因為害怕自己會把SARS病毒帶給家人,結果不敢回家,但又惦念着家裏的妻子,於是便相約妻子到公園「共聚」晚餐。他們夫妻俯各坐在枱的一角,兩人無言,但心中却有干言萬語,却不敢宣之於口,怕的是飛沫傳播病毒。看到這一幕,我深深地感受到可與家人共聚已經是一種幸福了。全港的醫護人員,你們真的辛苦了,你們為我們廢寢忘餐,捨生忘死地在前線抗戰;你們把人類的自我保護意識放下,把生死都置諸道外,把家人朋友們都暫且拋諸腦後,緊守著自己的崗位;你們意志堅強,雖然看見自己的戰友一個個倒下,抗SARS的道路越來越難行,但却無畏無懼,昂首向前。SARS病毒是強,但你們比它更強!「強人是你,能頂天立地」。沒錯,你們真的是頂天立地,真的撐起了香港的一片天空,使受SARS煎熬的港人呼吸到一口空氣,使在黑暗中的港人看到了光明。你們無私奉獻的精神感動了大家,也鼓勵了大家努力向前,齊心抗炎。你們真的成為了我們香港人的驕傲,香港人的英雄,我們真以你們為榮!對你們是無限的感激,但很遺憾我不能為你做些甚麼,不過我想為你們送上祝福和好好保重自己,這已是對你們另一種的報答。



It is my honour to station at Rosaryhill School (Business Studies Section). Unforgettable experience and memories blossomed under the meaningful life of school social work.




