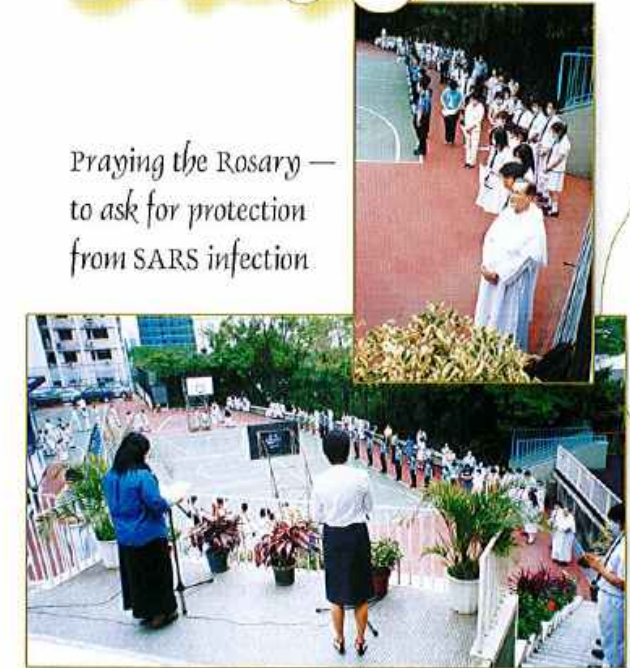

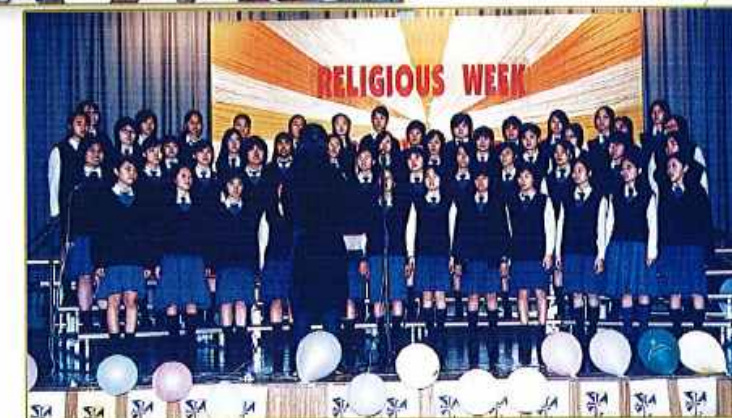

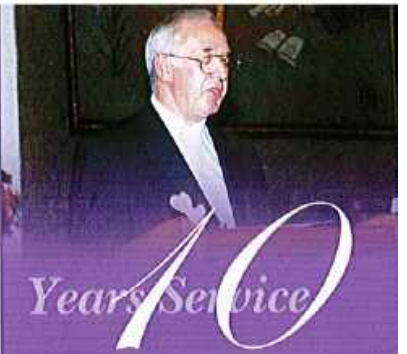
Christmas Celebration: A True to get together

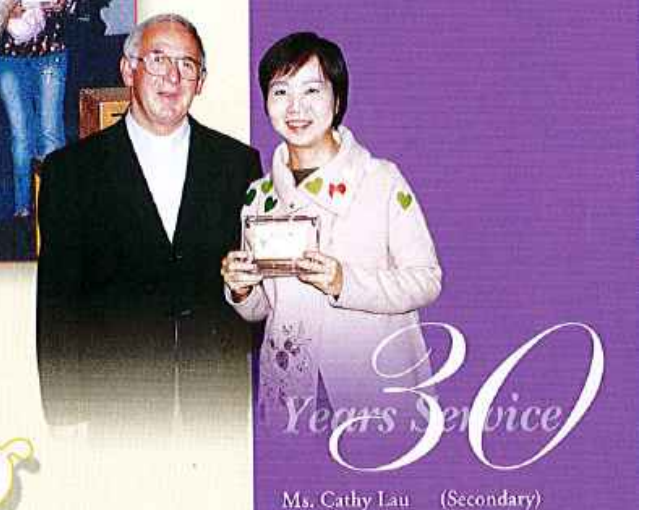

SARS Challenge and Response

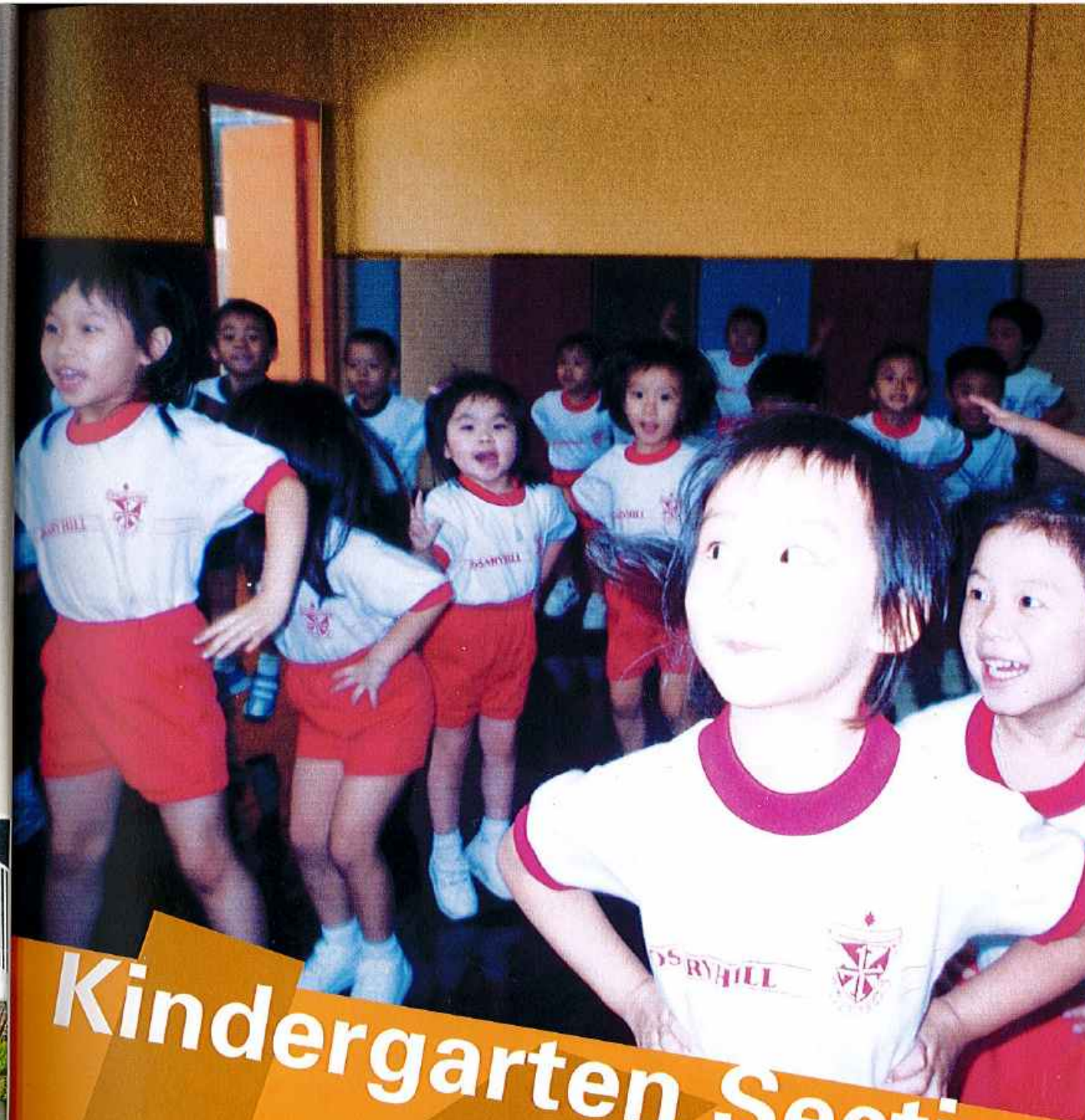
Hong Kong was hit and disrupted by the SARS crisis for almost two months. SARS virus put us in an unprecedented challenge and turned our daily life upside down as it came so unexpectedly and we were so unprepared for it. Everyone was anxious and worried about the crisis. Like the world around, Hong Kong was racing against time searching for the cause of SARS. SARS made life so fragile, uncertain and unprotected. We felt the deepest sympathy for SARS deaths but heartfelt salutes should go to those medical researchers and frontline professionals at the SARS battlefields for their great contributions and selfless devotion in the SARS crisis. Such chaos, however, made everyone of us more self reflective in our values, beliefs and practices. Everyone was fighting against SARS with courage and determination. We are also proud of the important breakthroughs in the biomedical field we have attained in the SARS confrontation. The SARS crisis has revitalized and instilled Hong Kong with a new sense of unity and determination to meet any challenges in the future.

SARS also posed a challenge to the school community. All schools in Hong Kong had been suspended for a month because of SARS. Suspension of classes did not break our home-school communications. Instead, we have developed a closer binding through emails and by phones. It is hoped that SARS will be eliminated in the near future.

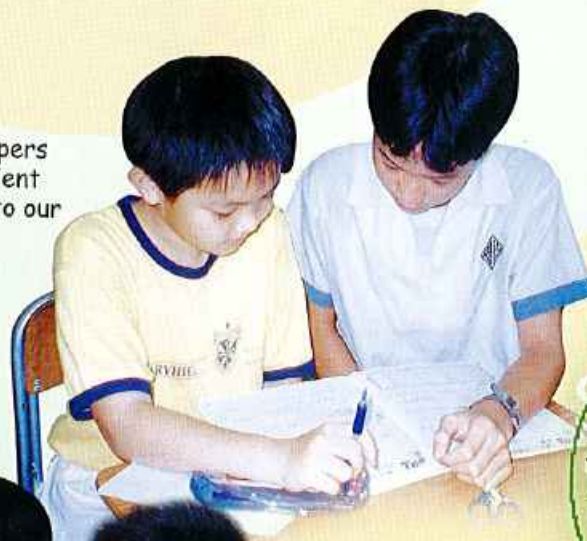

Everyone gathered for an English proverb session.



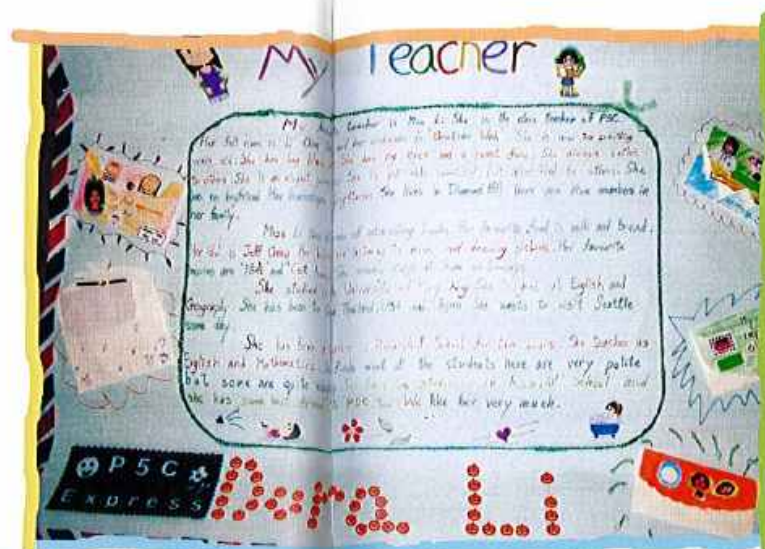

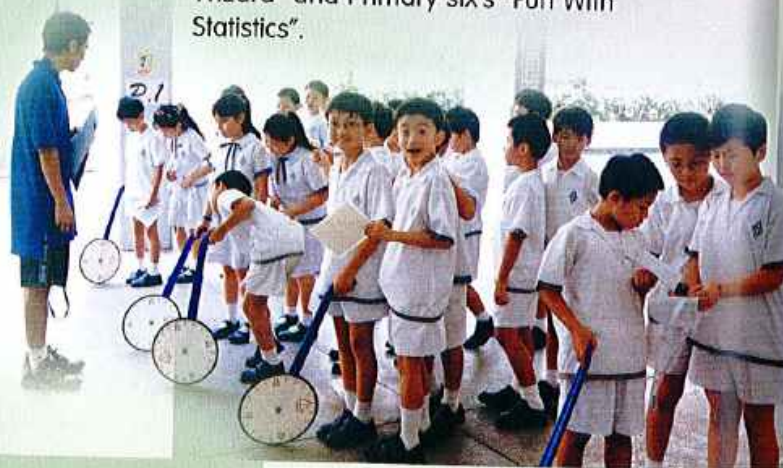

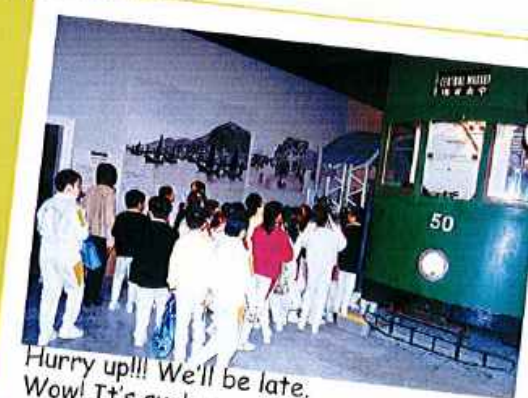
Eyes Wide Open: Educational Visit

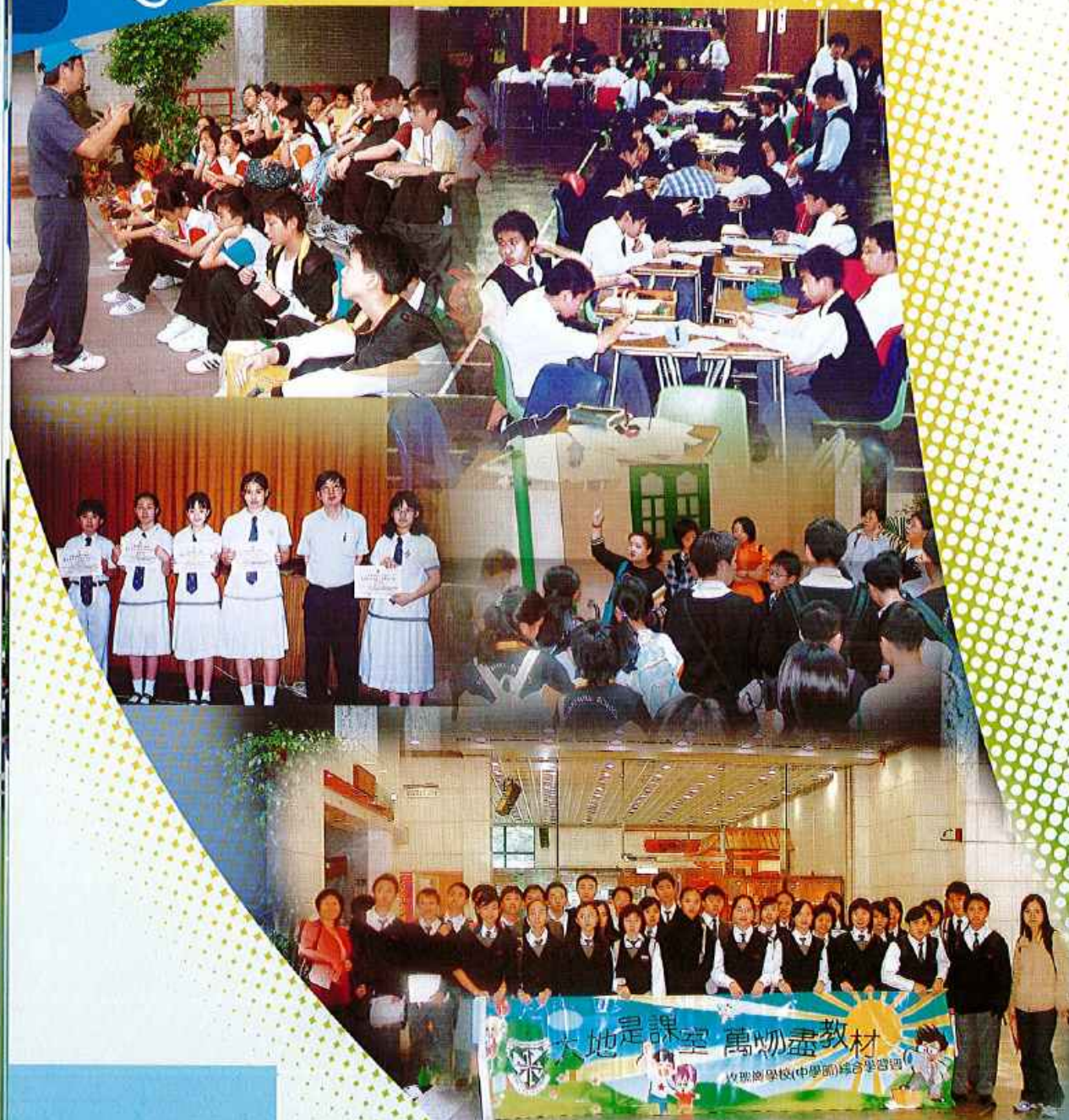
Visit Macau & China/ Services/Work Train



The Secondary 6 students were given the choice of participating in one of two trips: a six-day trip to Nanjing and Shanghai or a visit to Macau, Tong Guan and Guangzhou. Meanwhile, those who wanted to remain in Hong Kong could join the Work Training Programme which was arranged by the school. These students had the chance to work in places such as the University of Hong Kong, department stores or hospitals so as to gain work experience.



QEF Project - Searching for Innovation from Project Learning



"Searching for innovation from project learning" was an QEF project collaborated by six departments, namely the History department, the Chinese Language Department, the Geography Department, the Art Department, the Computer Studies Department, and the Putonghua Department. The project, which targeted all junior-level students, has synthesized different subject perspectives to examine a central theme and aimed to connect school to real living environment. Students were provided chances to learn outside classroom and were taught how to continue their learning with teachers' feedback in the process of project learning.

This QEF project was a continuation of the previous interdepartmental project which has been developed since 1998. Project learning was the new element added into this interdepartmental project. Project learning enables students to learn under teachers' scaffolding. During the Interim Week, students of S.1, S.2 and S.3 were taken to a walled village, Wan Chai and museums respectively to do their outside learning. They then discussed their project proposal with their team members and teacher advisors in the Project Learning Workshop the day immediately following their visit. To cater to students' learning diversities, different kinds of competitions, e.g. photo-taking competition, drawing competition and project learning competitions, were organized. Students' persevering efforts finally paid off and their outstanding work was displayed in the Subjects Exhibition held in early June.



Award for Arts Promotion

Arts education is of utmost importance not only to schools but also to our community. Indeed, this is particularly important in nurturing young people and enriching young minds. It was our honour to receive the Silver Prize of the Arts Development Award from the Hong Kong Arts Development Council.

The Award served as a commendation for schools which had outstanding achievement in arts education. The Arts Development Council had invited many prominent figures in the community to be the judges for the event. On 9 May, our Father Principal, together with the teachers responsible, attended the prize-presentation ceremony, which was held in the Hong Kong Ex-Government House. In the pamphlet of the ceremony, it was praised that 'Rosaryhill School has developed a systematic and integrated approach in promoting visual and performing arts (music, drama, dance, etc) among its students.'

What deserved special mention was the 'Trip to the Moon', a project that combined traditional language teaching with multi-media applications. It had, on the one hand, made language teaching much more vivid and, on the other hand, brought professional arts knowledge and skills from the outside world into the school, thus enhancing the creativity of our students and broadening the teachers' horizons. Our school had significant achievement in dancing, dramatic and musical performance, and we were awarded the Silver Prize. This honour was attributed to the efforts of all students and teachers in the school.

中文週第三、第四天活動以“玩樂”為主題，主要有風箏設計、踢毽及投壺比賽。

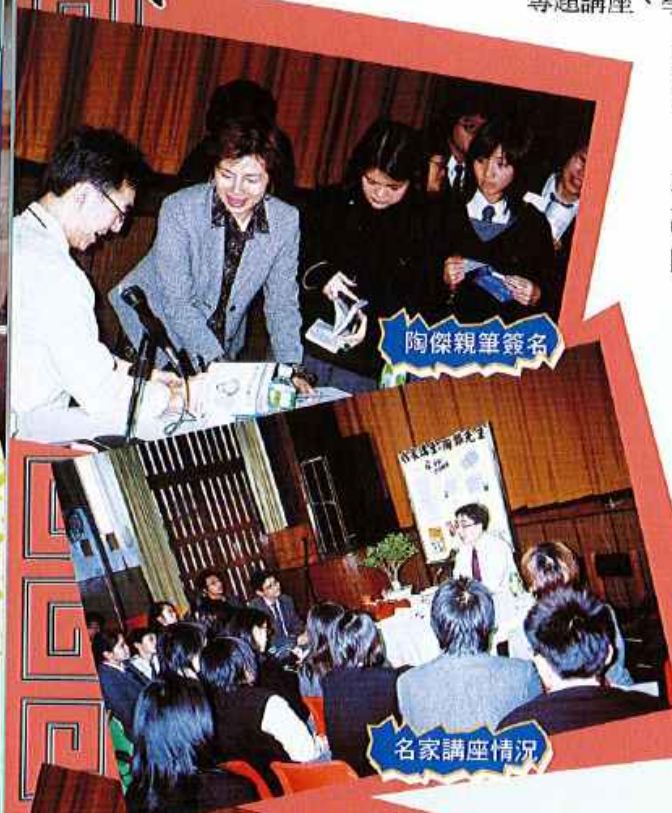

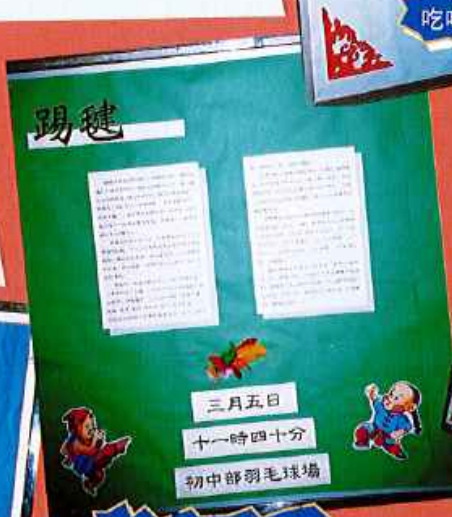

Our Way Forward in English Language Teaching and Learning

Moving in step with the curriculum reform which is in full swing, the English Department has been implementing new approaches in English teaching and learning. These approaches aim to develop students' communication skills, creative abilities as well as their study skills in general.

1. Students engaged in project work

The setting of the refurbished English Room facilitates small group discussion and project work among students.

2. Students learn to write poems

To develop their creativity and aesthetic abilities, junior form students are taught to appreciate poetry and produce their own poems.

3. Students interview tourists on the Peak

The interviewing activity trains students' oral skills and builds up their confidence in conversing with people of different nationalities.

4. The Hydroponics Club

Students communicate with the teacher-in-charge in English while planting and taking care of the plants.

5. Dramatization in lessons

Students develop their creativity and learn to express themselves through the use of drama during lessons.

6. Computer-assisted language learning

Students learn and improve their language proficiency using installed English learning software in the Computer Centre and e-class at home.



Wonderful Orienteering Experience at Rosaryhill



Orienteering in the school campus is fun. In March an exciting orienteering was jointly organized by the Geography Society, History Society and Smart Thinking Society. It attracted over 40 students. Each orienteering group was given a campus map and a compass to find points within the campus. It was highly competitive as the participants had to work as a team to search for as many control points as possible within a specified time and verify their visits by answering the questions at the points. It was a game of smart thinking as each orienteering group had to do their own navigating and make their own route choice. This orienteering experience enabled participating students to learn about maps, direction and apply what they have learnt in Geography and History lessons in a real-life situation.

According to many academic researchers, learning through peers has been proven to be very effective. The Remedial Studies Committee has launched a programme called 'Peer Tutoring' in view of facilitating students' learning. Nineteen S.1 students together with their S.3 and S.6 counterparts pair up to form small learning groups and the latter 'mentors' give private tutorial to the former tutees after school at regular intervals. As most S.1 students find it hard to handle mathematics, the focus on the tutorials is mathematics-related. The evaluation of the programme has been completed and it was very well received.

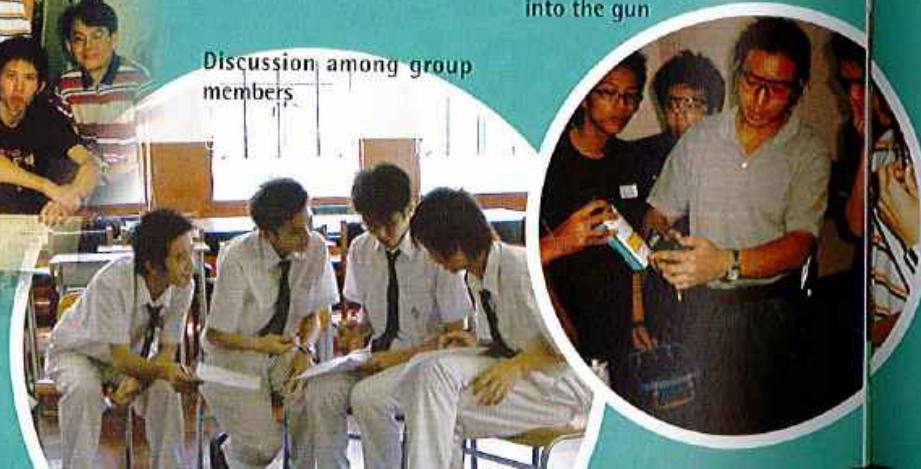

環境教育

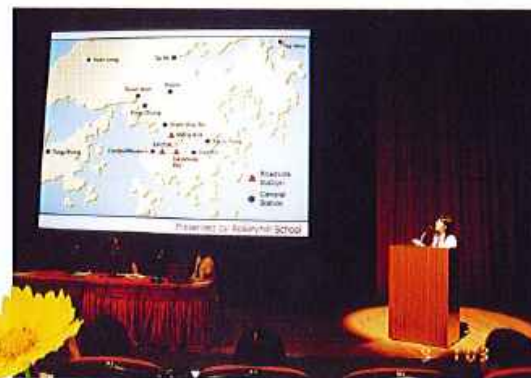

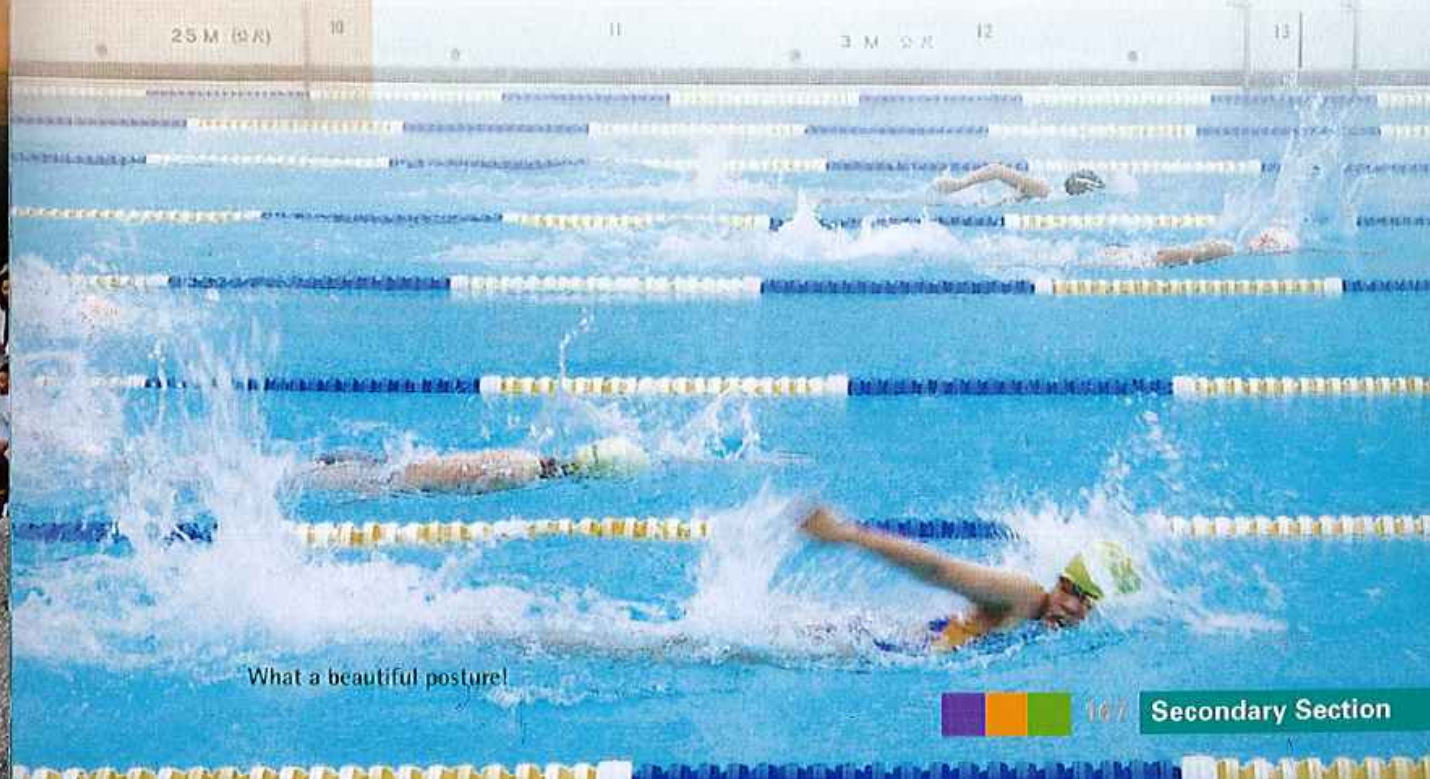

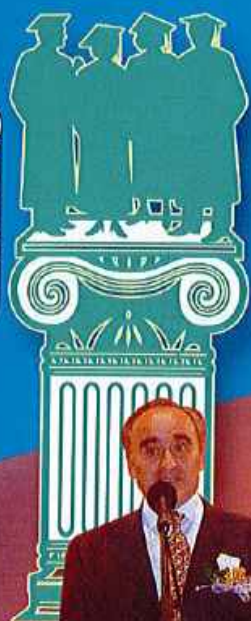

最後，大會播放了一段以老師向同學們道別的片段，結束了當晚的畢業謝師宴。



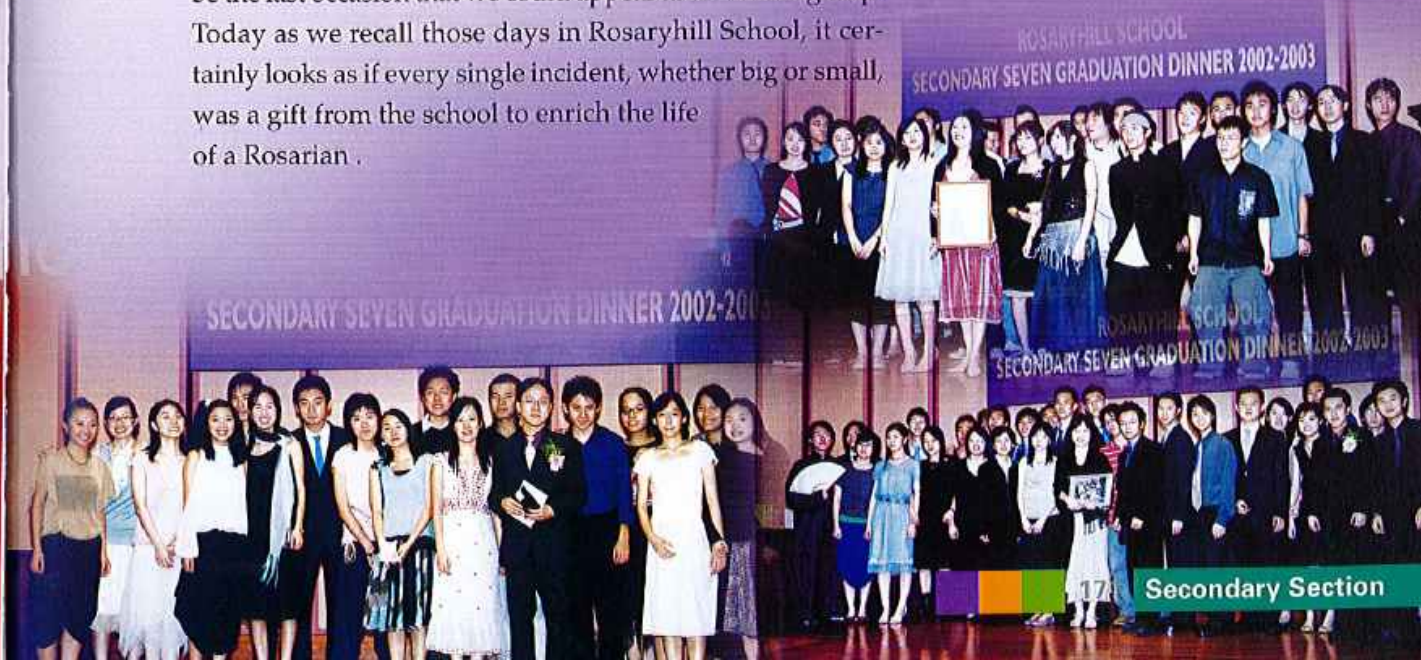

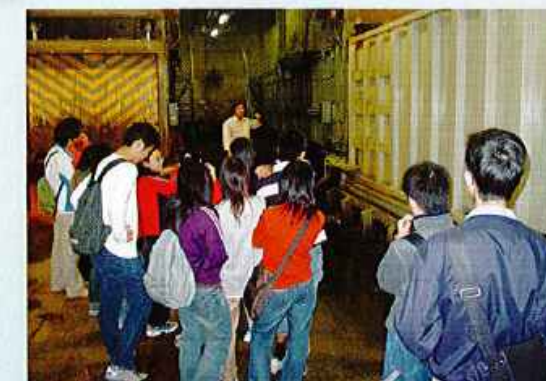

非典型肺炎與我

四月的香港沒有出現春天的希望和生機，反而是一片悲傷、恐懼、焦慮和不安。

「喂？你是不是陳俊豪呀！……」電話筒傳來熟悉的聲音——是我的班主任。雖然只是幾句的簡單的問候，裏面却包含了無限的關懷和愛心，撫平了我心的傷口，也驅散了我心頭的愁雲慘霧。

停課以來，我心沒有一天是開懷的。天天都困在家裏，心也像被困一樣，落落寡歡起來。為甚麼世界好像眨眼間變得混亂起來？伊拉克的戰火，香港受到非典型肺炎的侵襲，張國榮的逝世，為甚麼不好的事總愛接二連三地發生？只是短短的幾天裏，突然對「人生無常，世事多變」這八個大字感受良多。誰會想到一代的巨星也會自尋短見？誰會想到香港疲弱不堪的經濟還會遇上SARS，令經濟雪上加霜？香港的天好像一下子塌了下來，令人不敢想香港的將來，繁華的夜景還會繼續璀璨下去嗎？這一切真的令人吃不消，心靈壓力去到一下子超負荷的地步。我是不是應該大哭出來？「不行。」我對自己說。香港在這個時候更需要歡笑，我應該大笑，開懷大笑，但我無論怎嘗試「歡笑」，都只不過是強顏歡笑，那些不開心的事仍縈繞心頭，揮之不去。我覺得世界上的希望都好像消失了，眼前是一片漆黑。但是在我心靈快要乾時，覺得萬念俱灰時，班主任的幾句問候，使我心靈再滋潤起來，而醫護人員在前線不屈不撓地作戰，重燃了我對香港，對未來的希望。

我曾經在電視上看到很感人的一幕：一位抗SARS的醫生，因為害怕自己會把SARS病毒帶給家人，結果不敢回家，但又惦念着家裏的妻子，於是便相約妻子到公園「共聚」晚餐。他們夫妻倆各坐在枱的一角，兩人無言，但心中却有千言萬語，却不敢宣之於口，怕的是飛沫傳播病毒。看到這一幕，我深深地感受到可與家人共聚已經是一種幸福了。全港的醫護人員，你們真的辛苦了，你們為我們廢寢忘餐，捨生忘死地在前線抗戰；你們把人類自我保護意識放下，把生死都置諸道外，把家人朋友們都暫且拋諸腦後，緊守着自己的崗位；你們意志堅強，雖然看見自己的戰友一個個倒下，抗SARS的道路越來越難行，但卻無畏無懼，昂首向前。SARS病毒是強，但你們比它更強！「強人是你，能頂天立地」。沒錯，你們真的是頂天立地，真的撐起了香港的一片天空，使受SARS煎熬的港人呼吸到一口空氣，使在黑暗中的港人看到了光明。你們無私奉獻的精神感動了大家，也鼓勵了大家努力向前，齊心抗戰。你們真的成為了我們香港人的驕傲，香港人的英雄，我們真以你們為榮！對你們是無限的感激，但很遺憾我不能為你做些甚麼，不過我想為你們送上祝福和好好保重自己，這已是對你們另一種的報答。

在這場肺炎之中，雖然我沒有悟出甚麼樣的人生大道理，但卻深切體會明白到其實只要身體健康，和家人一起生活已是很幸福很幸福的事。還有，人與人的互相關懷很重要，簡單的幾句問候和關懷，帶給別人的是無限的溫暖，所以別吝嗇你對別人的關心！其實，香港人一點也不吝嗇對別人的關心，看看醫院門前滿是港人送上對醫護人員的祝福與慰問的心意卡，民間的籌款助非典型肺炎受害者的活動，港人一呼百應。處處都流露出港人的愛心，對別人的關懷，現在誰還會說香港是個冷漠的城市？

最後我衷心希望卧病在床的朋友堅持下去，我會為你們禱告，默默祝福你們。也希望在下一年春天的香港比以往更有生機和希望。

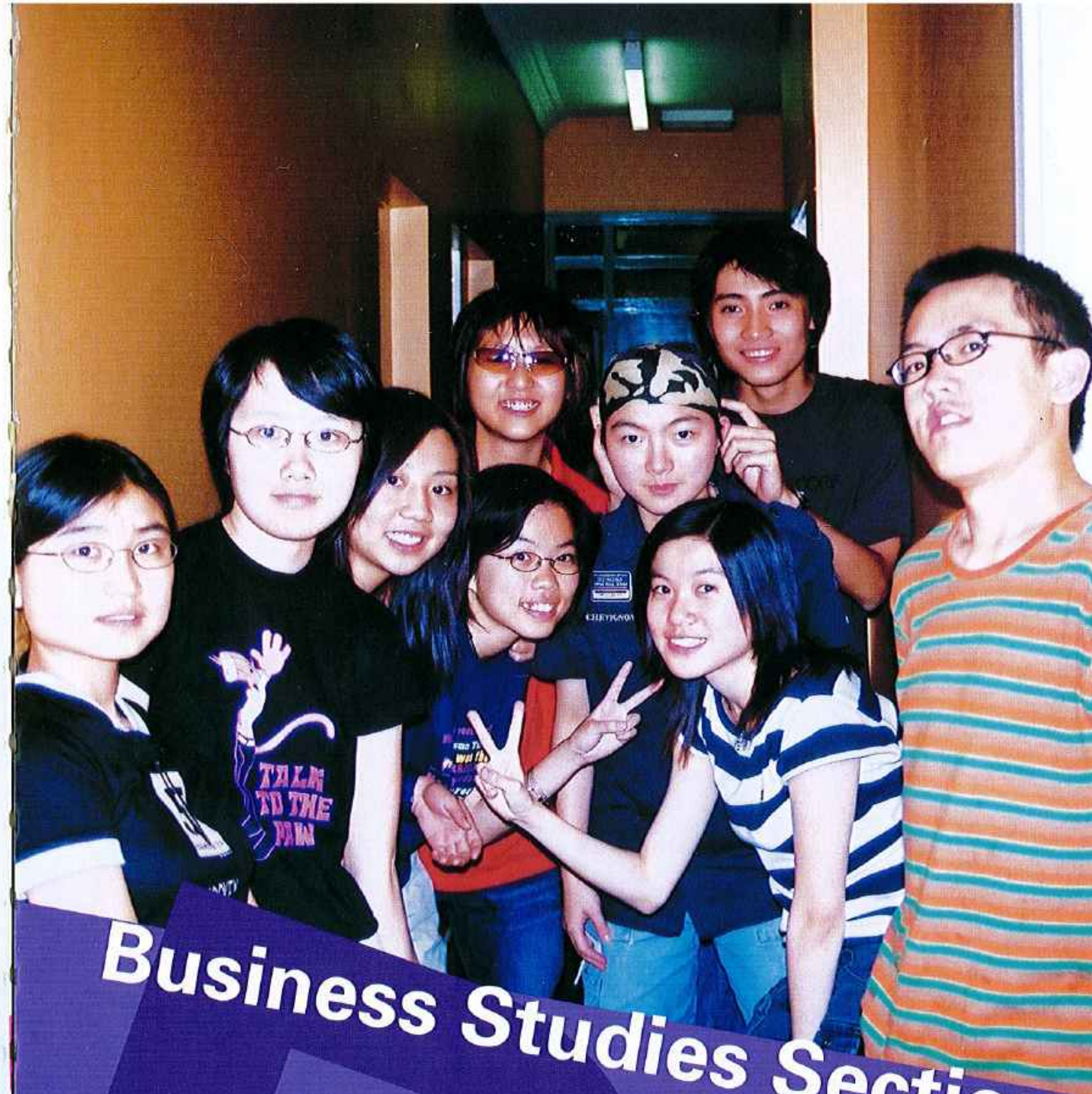

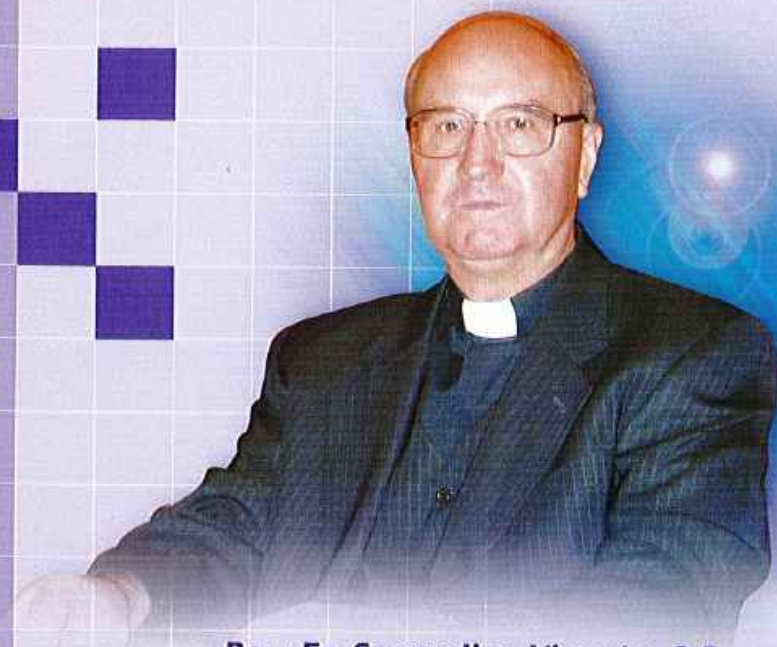

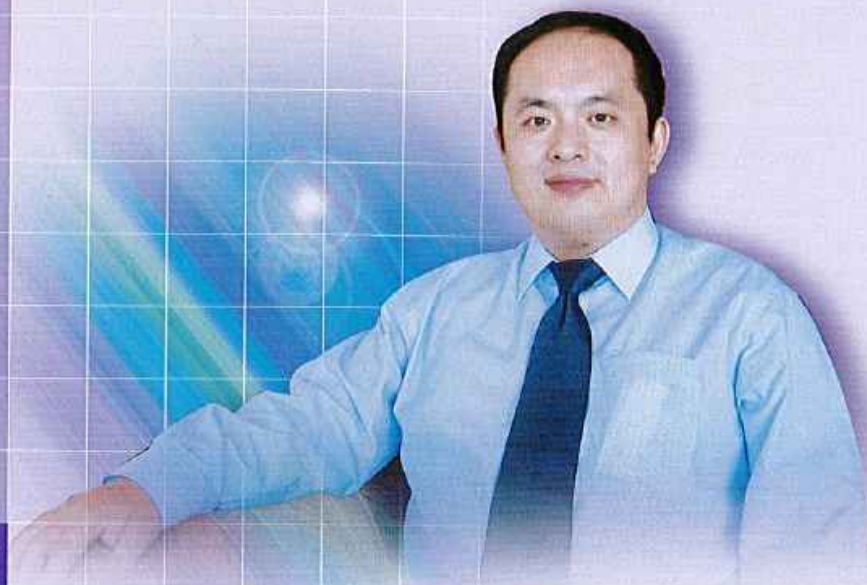

The walkathon was held on the 29th of January 2003 in Tai Tam Country Park. It was a perfect day for outing, sunny and yet cool.

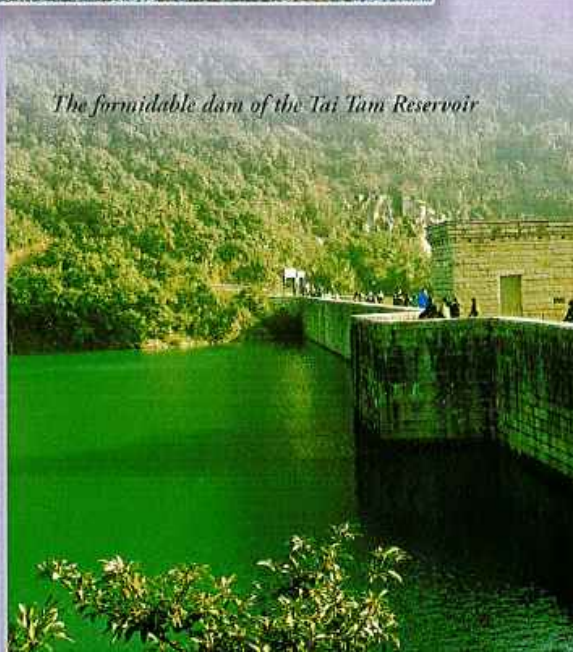

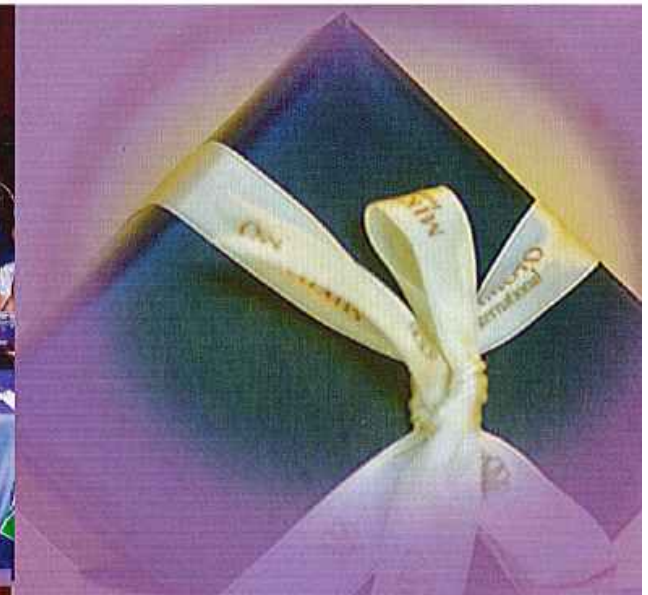
