
### X'mas Dinner@home


## THE FUN WORLD OF ENGLISH




Tt's Show Time!! Our students were very amazing. Students from different classes and levels showed us different kinds of talent. Like piano performance, drama and singing.


## OUR TREASURED GRADUATION

After the performance, the prize winners, parents, teachers and guests moved to the junior playground to enjoy the reception prepared by the teachers and senior students of the Home Economics Department. During the reception everyone was entertained by a mini performance by the School Orchestra.

The ceremony ended with the parents, teachers and students leaving with a sense of pride as they had all been able to experience the results of their hard work and dedication. It truly was a delightful day.









Father Principal began by welcoming everyone to the ceremony and introducing the guest of honour, Mr. Michael Tien. Father then gave a report on the events at the school over the past year.

Firstly the target to reduce the number of classes has been achieved, and will be maintained at the current level in the years to come. As well, the school administration has been restructured and streamlined to meet the challenge of new educational initiatives such as the new senior secondary curriculum. Concurrent with these changes, the various student bodies have been grouped together into a new overarching Student Leader group.

Father Principal spent some time talking about this year's interactions between RHS students from Japan, Singapore and Mainland China. As well as this, student performers from RHS visited and performed at schools on the mainland, and our sister school from Macau participated in the RHS annual sports tournament.

The Green School project continues at our school and the results have been exceptional. This year, the school received a certificate of merit from the Environmental Protection Committee. Also, positive outcomes for the newly implemeted Intergrated Huminities subject were noted. The creation of new syllabi and a textbook, and the sharing of experiences with other schools were some of the achievements mentioned.

Importantly, the School Improvement Program was finished during the school year. Father mentioned how the new facilities are now in use, and that these facilities have brought great benefits to the teachers, other staff members, and students of the school.

Father Principal noted the efforts and outstanding achievements of the day's prize recipients. These students, along with their teachers and the school staff in general, were praised for their untiring efforts and positive contributions.

In conclusion, Father Principal mentioned the mission of the school, based on the teachings of the founder of the Dominican Order, Saint Dominic. This mission is to develop in our students a sense of true Christianity, conscientious citizenship, and individual responsibility.

Father finished by again congratulating the students receiving awards, and their parents. A sincere vote of thanks was also given to the guest of honour, other distinguished guests, and attending parents, students and friends of Rosaryhill School.

































## ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION







According to one teacher: "The focus of project learning should not be on what students know but on how students behave when they don't know, and on how teachers help them in undertaking the project."
















# YOUTH AMBASSADOR SCHEME






The History Society has a long history of over I twenty years, aiming to foster and to promote the view that to study History is fun.



## THE SCHOOL ORCHESTRA






# SPORTS DAY


### **International Social Service Hong Kong Branch** School Social Work Service "Racial Harmony"~Rosary Carnival




## GRADUATION DINNER


We will never forget the experience of seeing these beautiful places. Actually, the study tour in England has given us fantastic memories!




