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MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERVISOR

My appointment as school supervisor came as a surprise, and first of all to myself. I have always thought that my duty in Rosaryhill School was a pastoral mission rather than administration. After one year in this position I have to be grateful to God for his mercy and grace and also for the countless people in the school who have helped me carry out my responsibility.

As the school supervisor I try to personify the mission of Rosaryhill School. Some of you may know that Spanish Dominicans first started to come to Asia many years ago in 1587. They left the security of being in their country for the risks of an unknown world. What was it that provoked them to leave home and travel toward the uncertainty? Maybe some of them took on the challenge as an adventure, but most of the missionaries were driven by a genuine desire to love, help and bring the Asian people closer to God. Rosaryhill School is the continuation of the same mission that was initiated long ago in the XVI century. Although the fathers and brothers serving in the school now are not only Spanish, in fact some of them have come from Asian countries, the mission is the same: to love, help and bring the people closer to God. It is the same Divine Spirit who enlivens and stimulates our work.

At this moment, the expression “Spiritual Education” has become familiar to many in Rosaryhill School. I believe that teachers and students will gradually come to appreciate more the purpose of Spiritual Education. The goal of education is not only feeding knowledge to the students, nor the goal of a Catholic education to simply convey some religious instructions. The purpose of education is to help the whole person grow. It is indeed a holy and sacred endeavor. Those of us who are involved in this task can feel that we are touching lives and sowing wholesome seeds in the hearts of many young lives.

In the Education Day 2016, the Catholic Education Office from the Catholic Diocese of Hong Kong published a very inspiring message in the Sunday Examiner. In this communication the essentials of the Catholic education are declared. It is said that “while secular education deals only with the human aspect, Catholic education deals with the transcendent. We teach not only to inform the mind, but to renew the mind. What goes into heads must move hearts and change lives.” This inspiring attitude echoes the meaning and purpose of spiritual education in Rosaryhill School. We want to see our students in their wholeness and in their beauty “as they are in the eyes of God”. It is our mission to provide a nourishing environment for students to grow spiritually, intellectually, emotionally and physically.

I have to express my sincere appreciation to the teachers in the different sections of Rosaryhill School. Their commitment and enthusiasm is the pride of our school. Thank you to the Dominican Fathers who continue to be faithful to their mission in a whole life of dedication. I want to mention here especially the roles and contributions of the Chinese Dominican Students. It is a great blessing to have them in Rosaryhill School. It fills me with joy when I see them joining in the Morning Prayer at the secondary section, teaching Religious Knowledge classes at the Primary section and being involved in many other school activities. These Brothers represent the future of the Order and also the future of the school.

I would like to finalize my message by invoking the protection of our mother Mary, the Queen of the Rosary and the Patron Saint of Rosaryhill School. May all of us at the School never be lack of anything that is essential for our growth and true happiness.

DEPARTMENT OF RELIGION

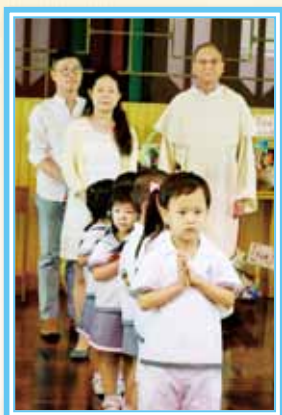

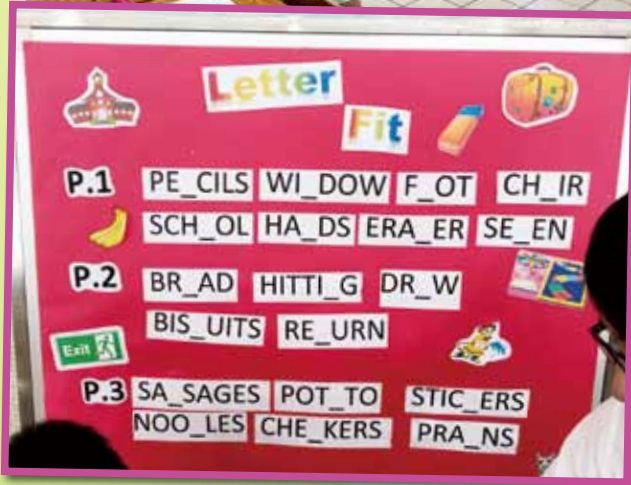
For our activity days, we started off with the Speech Festival, where our students showed their ability to display perfectly spoken English while competing with each other.

Finally, we could not forget the poem recitals, which once again were a big success. The students loved memorizing and reciting their poems on stage. All the teachers felt extremely proud of them!



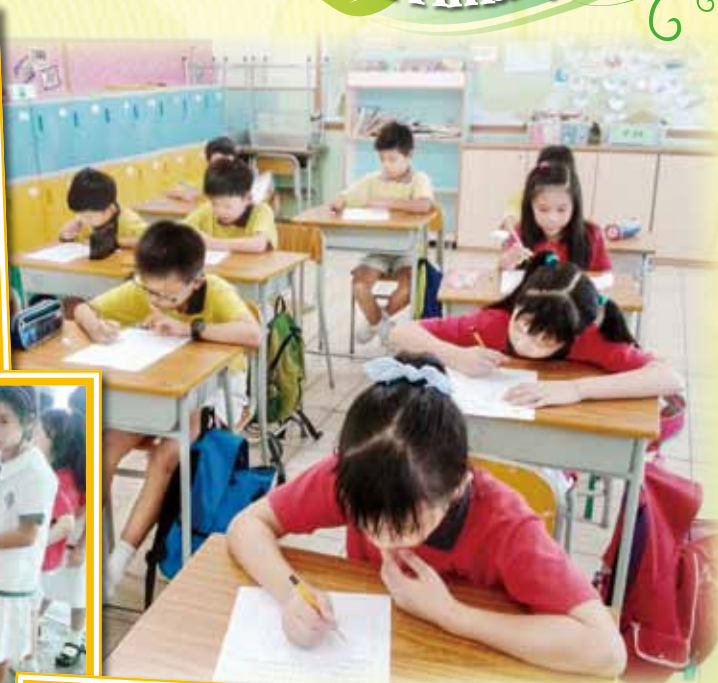


MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

On 29 June 2016, Primary 1 to 5 students took part in our Mathematics Day. We had mathematics booths, activities and competitions. Primary 5 students were responsible for holding the game booths and leading Primary 1 to 4 students through the games. Primary 1 and 2 students enjoyed their "multiplication" activities. Also, Primary 3 and 4 students liked to participate in the mathematics competition. In general, the various activities allowed students to learn mathematics through games and fun.





GENERAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT

This year, our students went to different places in Hong Kong for their project learning activities. For Primary 1 students, they learnt about different plants and animals from the Hong Kong Zoological and Botanical Garden and the Victoria Park. Primary 2 students studied the manufacturing process of Coca Cola from the Coca Cola Factory. Primary 3 students visited the Hong Kong Science Museum in order to strengthen their awareness of the importance of environmental conservation. Primary 4 students went to the Water Resources Education Centre to learn about the importance of water conservation. Primary 5 students visited the Hong Kong Jockey Club Drug InfoCentre that provided the opportunity to learn about different kinds of drugs through anti-drug activities. Primary 6 students learnt about the criminal judicial system and correctional services from the Reflective Path Program organized by the Hong Kong Correctional Services.

In order to arouse students' interest in learning about nature, this year our Primary 1 to 6 Science Exploration Day was relocated to Hong Kong

Disneyland for the Disney Youth Education Series. For Primary 1, they discovered the history, creativity, and innovation behind the creative process of animation by completing Disney's Animation Magic. For Primary 2 and 3, students gained an understanding of how Walt Disney Imagineers use synergy to create attractions where the whole is greater than the sum of its parts by completing Synergy in Science. For Primary 4 and Primary 5, Disney's Environmental Exploration highlighted examples from Hong Kong Disneyland, explored ways to reduce resource consumption in daily life, and enabled students to have a diversified and lifelong learning experience in environmental protection and sustainable development. For Primary 6, students participated in Disney's World of Physics explored Theme Park and were amazed and enlightened through hands-on experiments. These programmes provided an ideal learning experience for the "People and Environment" portion of the General Studies curriculum.





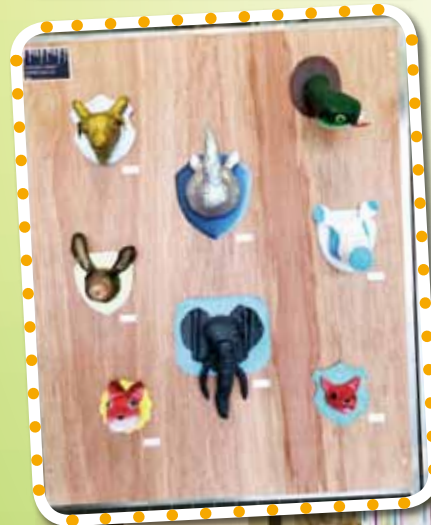
VISUAL ART DEPARTMENT

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & HUMANITIES EDUCATION

ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT

BUSINESS, ACCOUNTING AND FINANCIAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT

This year the Economics and BAFS Department provided an opportunity to 20 S.4 students and 5 S.5 students to join a 4-hour personal finance workshop organized by JA Personal Finance in April.

An experienced business volunteer was invited to share her experiences with the students on her own personal financial management. She led the students in sessions that used group activities, real-life examples and practical tools. Students learnt essential skills such as budgeting, different payment methods and credit options. They became more familiar with the value of savings and investments as well as terminology relating to the stock market. The workshop equipped students with the tools to make wise and responsible financial decisions throughout their careers and lives.



GEOGRAPHY DEPARTMENT

Field study is an indispensable part of Geography. In October, our S.3 students took part in an Orienteering exercise at Tai Mo Shan. Students not only applied the map reading skills learnt, but also experienced the use of GPS.



In March, our S4 Geography students attended a 2-day field study course on Cheung Chau. They carried out two research projects on "Disappearing Green Canopy," and "Coastal Environment".



Our S.5 Geography students also had a field trip at Chuen Lung in March. They examined the water quality of Tai Tso Stream by collecting water samples at different checkpoints and conducting water tests in the laboratory. They identified the sources of pollution in the study area.

Secondary Section

HISTORY DEPARTMENT

Local heritages contribute to our own cultural identity and sense of place. Every year, the History Department arranges some outings. In May, S5 students visited Western historical buildings in Central as well as the pillar of shame in HKU. Students got a good chance to learn more about Hong Kong's history and Hong Kong's relationship with Mainland China by exploring these vivid historic buildings and historic sites.



To further promote students' creativity, we also organized a History poster design and a slogan design competition. The results were very encouraging as we received many pieces of good work.

The History Department also awarded certificates to those students who performed well during the year and those who made positive progress in their History learning. The awards aim to encourage students' positive learning outcomes and strengthen their confidence in learning.



INTEGRATED HUMANITIES DEPARTMENT

In order to make students better understand the history of Hong Kong in the 20th century, our department designed a new activity, "Knowing Hong Kong Streets – Old and New Faces". The activity not only helped students to better appreciate the changes that development has made to Hong Kong, it also gave them a chance to visit and explore in detail their street.

So junior students could better understand Hong Kong's political system, the department designed a booth and worksheets for academic relating to the Legislative Council election. Students were able to learn about the division of districts, electoral system and their civic rights regarding elections. All these activities are aimed to enhance their understanding of Hong Kong and their civic awareness. We believe experiential learning can deepen students' knowledge spectrum and raise their learning interest.



RELIGIOUS STUDIES DEPARTMENT

In view of helping students to follow Christ's exemplary personality and to imitate His spirit of love, the Religious Studies Department encourages students to build a positive outlook on life filled with care, faith and empathy towards others.

The theme of our Religious Week this year was "Go and Preach". Colouring and photography competitions were organised for junior form students and the senior form students, who had taken Religious Studies as their elective, visited the brothers in the St Dominic Centre.



A special Mass was also conducted and Mr Joseph Yip and Miss Angela Chan both gave talks and shared their experiences with the school. Lastly, in the hope of promoting harmony and integration, our students participated in a Bible reading activity by reading the Bible in different languages.

PHYSICS DEPARTMENT

The Physics Department co-organised the S.1 - S.3 Inter-class Spelling Competition and the S.4 - S.5 Science Quiz with other Science departments. These activities provided students with a valuable opportunity to use what they have learnt in Science lessons and to arouse their interest in learning Science. The Secondary

School Maths and Science Competition (organized by Poly. U) was held on 24 April, 2016. Three elite S.5 Physics students were selected to join it. S.5A Wise Wang obtained "Distinction" and S.5A Mikey Liu obtained "Credit".

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INTEGRATED SCIENCE DEPARTMENT

The Integrated Science Spelling Competition was held in the 2nd Academic week. Four representatives were selected from each class to join the competition.

There was an exciting competition atmosphere and class representatives performed to their best. In the first spelling part the runners ran fast to get more word cards and the other 3 representatives wrote down the correct spelling of scientific words. In the second part of the competition all 4 representatives worked together to complete designated experimental steps within a specific time limit.



COMPUTER DEPARTMENT

Our curriculum is shifting from using software to online applications. Students can now easily access the same working platforms they use in the computer lesson at home. We have also focused on programming in the junior levels and students have learnt how to write applications using Scratch and App Inventor. Over 60 students participated in the programming event "Hour of code" this year.

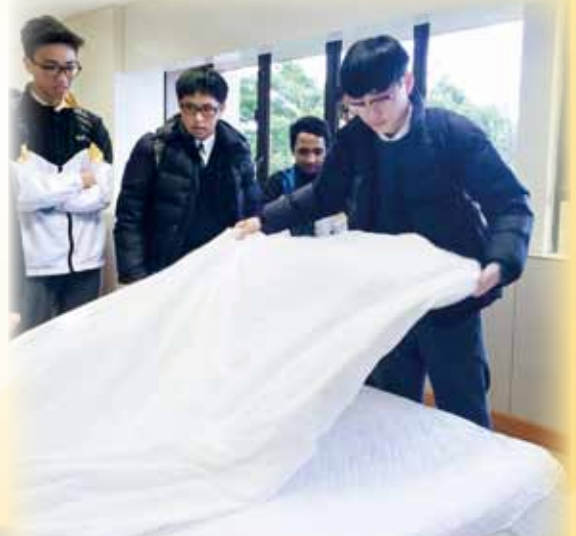


CAREERS AND GUIDANCE TEAM

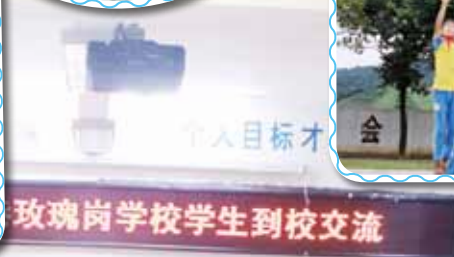


VOLUNTARY VISIT TO QINGYUAN
