



Message from the Supervisor

Dear Friends,

It is my honour to greet you and share with you through the Rosaryhill school annual. Our school was founded by the Dominican Fathers more than 60 years ago and is situated in the mid-levels in Wan Chai. Situated on the northern hillside of Hong Kong Island with a rich historical tradition of "ample" school campus with about 140,000 square feet. It is famous on its beautiful environment, good resources and modern facilities for students to study and for teachers to teach in and its good class size structure and student population arrangement is favoured by most of the stakeholders.

This year, the Dominican Family celebrates the 800th Jubilee Year anniversary of the death of St. Dominic, our founder. St. Dominic de Guzman is known not only as an eminent preacher and man of God, but also as a good educator, loving, patient and tolerant to his followers. Department of Religion

If the previous academic year 2019-2020 was an irregular one, unfortunately the situation has not improved in the year 2020-2021. We have continued to suffer many restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic.

There has been a lingering feeling of dissatisfaction due to having to cancel many of our religious activities. All these measures have affected the spiritual climate in our school.

In the Primary Section, we have tried to continue with the Morning Prayer, but how difficult has it been! We could not go to the covered playground and experience the encouragement and support of the big assembly praying and singing together. How much I miss that! We had to content ourselves to go to one classroom and then broadcast it to the other



classes by Zoom. We can say that it was better than nothing, and the students had the chance to pray and receive spiritual blessings at the beginning of the day.

In the Secondary School, our presence has also been very much curtailed. The same as in the private sections, the schooling time was limited by the EDB and these restrictions have made it impossible to have a regular Morning Prayer, as we used to have in the school chapel. Instead, once a week, we had a Prayer session by Zoom. As the father in charge of the Department of Religion, I tried to encourage and provide spiritual nourishment to our teachers and students. But the conditions were so limiting! The possibility of interaction and feedback was nearly absent, but we tried our best.

This annual report seems to be a long series of complaints, and this is not how I would like to transmit my message. I would like to emphasise the importance of cultivating a spiritual



atmosphere in Rosaryhill School, because this is the best contribution we can offer to our students. And as an example, I would like to share the experience of a friend of mine who worked in our school, and now she is trying to help in the Sunday school of a Hong Kong Parish. She told me that the Sunday school students, mostly P3 and P4, were nice and friendly, but they did not have the spiritual maturity of the students in our Primary Section. She said that the parish students were very superficial in their answers and sharing, whereas our students were much more serious and profound,

as they have received a better spiritual education. I was so impressed and gladdened by this observation! I only hope that the Holy Spirit may continue to inspire and strengthen us to carry on our mission for the spiritual well-being of our teachers and students. This is what really matters and I pray to our Mother Mary, Queen of the Rosary and Patron Saint of Rosaryhill School to cover us with her protection, each and every one of the persons working and studying in our school.

May God, the Lady of the Rosary, and our Father St. Dominic bless us all.

本校中文科在一至三年級推行「普教中」,使學生在低年級階段打下良好的普通話基礎。四至六年級推行「粤教中」,為學生升中做好充足的準備。中文科通過互動教學、活動體驗、合作學習及寓教於樂的方式,為學生創造良好的語言學習環境,藉此開發學生潛能,培養學生對中文學習的熱愛,從而提升教與學的效能。

今年學校開展了第一屆「講故事大賽」,活動報名火 爆,有超過一百名同學報名,希望通過講故事比賽鼓勵學生 熱愛閱讀,分享閱讀過的好書,同時鍛煉演講能力。

雖然今年疫情,但學校依舊克服層層困難,舉辦和開展了很多豐富多彩的課外活動,增強學生對中國傳統文化的認知,提升學生對中文學習的興趣,開拓學生視野。例如,通過精彩紛呈的中秋、新年慶祝活動,讓學生了解文化習俗,建立傳承文化意識;Zoom時通過線上,帶領學生參加有趣的益智遊戲,通過猜謎等互動遊戲,體驗中國傳統文化。在試後活動日,學生有機會逛花市,購買心儀的玩具和學習用品,享受購物帶來的快感!

今年,本校不少學生報名參加了「知行教育基金會」舉辦的「知行杯」讀後感寫作比賽,其中3B 班的金庭如同學和3S2班的朱羲雯同學在三百多份參賽作品中脫穎而出,分別獲得「創意無限獎」和「鼓舞人心獎」。










English Department

Music Department

After a long year beset with many challenges, the Music Department has made many adaptations. For example, some online music workshops related to music creation and RTHK Music radio channel were conducted through Zoom. Luckily, two performances can be taken place at school. One of them was a great music drama performed and organized by Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra. The other one is an orchestral performance organized by Hong Kong Music Office.

During December, as to spirit up and bring happiness to students and parents during the pandemic, the School Music team has launched a project called "Rosaryhill School Christmas Singing Project (RHSCSP)", which allowed 40 Rosaryhill School students to form a Virtual choir and sing a Christmas carol called "Frosty the Snowman". This proved to be most popular and we shall continue this if possible. Performers were awarded a certificate as a token of thanks on Thanksgiving day afterwards.











Computer Studies Department



Our Computer Studies Department have been implementing new curriculum by incorporating coding and STEM education.

By developing students' thinking and problem-solving ability, as well as unleashing students' creativity through task-based activities, our students can be able to use it into every aspects of their lives.

Students are exposed to STEM, giving them opportunities to explore with their creativity, they will develop a passion for it and hopefully allow them to apply it to their own lives. A curriculum that is STEM-based has real-life situations to help the student learn.

As for P.2, ScratchJr was introduced as a method to learn coding. Coding for kids is like a form of writing as it can help people express their ideas and organize their thoughts. Students are given the ability to turn their thoughts, emotions, and ideas into actual visual, visible concepts.

Apart from STEM, fundamental skills are also important and students attained amazing results in the DrPcFamily Typing Competition.













Visual Arts Department

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Library and Reading Scheme











This year, the school scheduled morning reading lessons for the students. Each week our students had two reading lessons. Chinese reading lessons alternated with English reading lessons every fortnight.

Each reading lesson is divided into three parts. The first part involves storytelling by the teachers concerned, and students complete relevant worksheets. In the second part, students share stories they have read or do roleplays for characters they have read in their storybooks. The last part is quiet reading time for the students, and they can borrow the boks from the library in classroom. The also spend time to finish their reading projects to help them improve their reading and writing skills.

Other than having reading lessons in the classrooms, students also could visit the school library to broadened dtheir reading horizons and learn about about library etiquette. The teachers on duty were able to recommend suitable books for them to enjoy some quiet reading time.

This year, there are two reading lessons per week. During the reading lessons, students were guided by the teacher to read the stories and finish the worksheets. Students can learn some reading skills from reading lessons. Also, the classroom provides a reading corner for the students. They can enjoy reading in the recess.













Extra-Curricular Activities

A series of educational and enjoyable free extracurricular activities were launched for our primary students both in Zoom meetings and at school. The students can enrich their sense of team spirit and of discipline through activities such as the Cubs, the Brownies, Physical Challenges, Cup Song, and Theatre Games. 

Some Mathematics teachers were honored to be the guest speakers and be able to host 3 different sharing sessions on School-based Professional Support Services for EDB.






Uberal Studies Department

This year, our students ioined various moral and civic education related activities, namely "Law abidingness" and "Empathy" Poster Design Competition organised by the Curriculum Development Council, Intellectual Property Protection Quiz Competition and Short Clip Competition organised by the Hong Kong Reprographic Rights Licensing Society, Together a Better Internet Mascot Design Competition organised by the Hong Kong Family Welfare Society, Cyber Security Competition organised by the Hong Kong Police Force and Voice for the Planet Challenge organised by the Lumivoce.

These events and activities have given students opportunities to apply the knowledge and skills they learnt and enrich their learning experiences in their Liberal Studies journey.

History Department

To arouse students' interest in studying history and enable students to conduct self-directed learning through the e-Reading platform, History Department participated in the Junior Secondary History e-Reading Award Scheme 2021 organized by the PSHE Section, EDB, and the e-Learning Development



Laboratory, HKU and co-organised by the History e-learning Schools Network. This scheme allows students to have more exposure in history readings and chances to compete for the 'Creativity Award' to showcase their talent and creativity in the e-Reading Scheme.



In April, History Department collaborated with the Chinese History Department to join an experiential learning activity, WARZONE 90, organized by the Humanitarian Education Centre of Hong Kong Red Cross. "WARZONE90" is the first exploration zone on war in Asia. The exploration programme adopts a 4E's education pattern – Explore, Experience, Exchange and Engage. The activity enables the students to cultivate a sense of humanitarian care and build up humanitarian perspectives in order to respond to the everchanging environment in the world.

中國歷史科



Integrated Humanities Department

In order to consolidate students' knowledge in National Education, the IH Department arranged a self-directed activity "Knowing the Chinese President – Xi Jinping "for the S2 students. Students learnt the profile and achievements of President Xi by watching a short video and collecting the information on the Internet. The performance of students was good. This is also a great chance for them to learn more about our Chinese Presidents.



Economics Department

Due to Covid-19, Chinese Flower Market could not be hosted as scheduled. However, 4 preparation stages were done successfully. Students learnt how to perform market research, write business proposals, and raise capital for their companies. The final stage of returning money back to shareholders was done upon liquidation of the companies.

Through this project, our school succeeded in fostering students' growth by improving students' social skills and enhancing their resilience. At the same time, the 4 preparation stages also helped to foster students' entrepreneurial spirit.







Geography Department

Though field learning has been suspended, students were still able to attend 'field trips' virtually through Zoom and mini field trips on the school campus. Project learning about conservation and development of the Wan Chai District jointly organized by History Department enabled students to make good use of online learning as a support of face-to-face learning.



Students were motivated to become co-constructors of knowledge through different collaborative and cooperative learning activities. Google doc was used as one of the collaborative learning platforms for students to discuss with one another and divide learning tasks into simpler and more manageable ones. The concept map drawing activities offered them hands-on experience to strengthen Geography learning with the use of graphic organizers.

Religious Studies Department

During the Religious Week, all students and religious teachers wrote prayers for the people who suffered during the pandemic. Some prayers were selected and uploaded in a video and shared with the students during the LEP.

To develop students' talents in creativity and imagination, there was also an S3 cross-curricular activity entitled "The Greatest Teacher" held by the Religious Department and the Chinese History Department. Students succeeded in drawing Jesus and other historical figures as their greatest teachers.





Biology Department





To promote STEM education in Science KLA, we nominated two teams to join the 'Ocean Park STEAM Student Competition 2021". Students had to implement their proposal by constructing a prototype of their proposed designs. They had to submit their prototype and a video, and presented their video in the Final Round Presentation.

The two teams nominated by our school got outstanding and remarkable results. Both teams have been selected as the finalists and the team of S5 Biology students was crowned the CHAMPION of the theme - 'Butterfly Friendly Garden'.

Physics Department

In order to enhance the effectiveness of online Physics learning and teaching, Google classroom, Google form, Google Meet, eclass, etc. have been fully utilised. In order to better prepare S.6 students for the HKDSE Physics exam, Whatsapp study groups were formed, where discussion about Physics learning could be enhanced.





Teaching aids which were shown in the pictures could enhance the effectiveness of Physics learning and teaching. Moreover, they make Physics learning and teaching more vivid and more fun.

Experiments play an important role in Physics learning, and some user-friendly equipment/apparatus have been introduced. Hence, experiments could then be run more smoothly and effectively.

Integrated Science Department

Science is based on evidence. Scientists find things out by conducting scientific investigations.

Therefore, doing investigations in the laboratory is the most important activity in the lessons.

Computer Studies Department

Our curriculum is shifting from using software to web-based application. Students can easily access the same working platform at home as in school. It reduces the barrier of learning via online lessons.

To prepare students for the revised ICT curriculum in the senior form, more programming elements were introduced in the junior curriculum.



In order to promote STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) education, we have enriched the content of programming in micro:bit. (a microcontroller board – Micro:bit) in the junior forms.

As for the senior ICT curriculum, we continue to utilize the materials from Cisco Academy to provide updated information in the IT industry. Due to the pandemic, we could not arrange any visits or IT workshops for students. Instead, we arranged some online webinars organized by a tertiary institute for our students.

Business, Accounting and Financial Studies Department

Junior Achievement Hong Kong International Trade Challenge Workshop

This year S4 and S5 BAFS students joined a half-day online International Trade Challenge Workshop organized by the Junior Achievement Hong Kong in May 2021.

The workshop provided a unique opportunity for students to learn about international trade and gain hands on experience through guidance from the business volunteers. During the workshop, small groups of students learnt to create Market Entry Strategy Plan for the assigned product and try to expand it overseas. Not only could the students learn some basic marketing concepts, but also some communication and presentation skills. The students found the workshop interesting and useful. Certificates were presented to students upon completion.



Arts Education

This academic year, teaching and learning activities were affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. The use of online learning becomes popular amongst students and their knowledge of information technology was raised. The online musical training programme

The Blessed Curse

Will COVID-19 ever end? Will our lives ever become normal again? These are questions we have all been thinking about in the back of our mind and wanting the answer to it, yet it just never seems to come. A year ago, a harmless-looking virus came to Hong Kong and became the world's number one threat causing millions of casualties, demolishing our society, and destroying our freedom. It is much more than a health crisis; it's also an unprecedented socio economic crisis. These alarming cases cause the government to take action and adopt a new lifestyle for us to survive throughout this pandemic. I have chosen the topic "oral history" to write about the Coronavirus because although each one of us handles this situation differently, we all have one thing in common in the end and that's how our lives have been affected due to the situation. Therefore, in this essay, I have interviewed different people from different walks of life to talk about how COVID-19 has affected their lives. The aspects covered are work life, study life, and family life.

The aspect that has challenged every adult is work life. I selected my mother to represent this theme as we own an employment agency, a large business creating the most profit for our financial stability that ended up becoming our downfall in the pandemic. She started her company years ago in Hong Kong. This employment agency aims to help Filipinos find employment opportunities as a maid, gardener, or any jobs due to the fact that one-fifth of the people in the Philippines live below the poverty line. Although they still go to work every day, their customers do not share the same view, and many stay home. Due to the restrictions the government has implemented, fewer people are willing to go out. Even though there has been no business, the agency has been opening while expenses and confirmed cases of COVID-19 are on the rise. This virus has had the biggest effect as her business gathers people from the Philippines in need of a job to work in Hong Kong. However, since the virus has spread worldwide, it isn't as easy to fly overseas anymore. In fact, it has become dangerous to fly as it increases the risk of spreading the virus.

The pandemic has resulted in both employers and employees seeking alternative work arrangements, which cause more difficulties in the business industry, especially for our family. Not only does it affect them but us children too, watching our parents struggle and not being able to lend a hand also affects our mentality.

This leads to the effects of COVID-19 on teenagers. Study life for students has become a living nightmare. Due to the situation, there is an unbearable cycle of switching from face to face classes to online classes depending on the current situation, which disrupts our focus. I believe this pandemic is the hardest on us, youths. Since these are the prime years of our lives and we waste it all at home as if our lives are on pause.

I have initiated a survey on social media asking, "How does COVID-19 affect your school life?" to get perspectives from

all secondary students in different schools instead of just interviewing one. As expected, whether both privileged or unprivileged students are losing their interest to learn. As students, the amount of time spent in isolation has damaged our mental health to the point that many have become unproductive and unwilling to learn. Many felt that sitting and staring at our devices for half a day continuously is incredibly draining and boring. It's self-explanatory to why teachers have been giving more work to students, however, the outcome isn't as expected. Students are struggling to make it through every deadline and put in less effort than usual, some have even come close to even giving up. I agree that technology is the best solution for us to continue our studies, but it seems that it doesn't help students at all. It has made learning a lot more difficult as grades are dropping and the drive to do our best in studies is diminishing.

My family life during the pandemic was quite traumatizing. Supposedly, this is a chance for all families to bond as they can spend time together during lockdown but mine was a completely different story. I've interviewed my father on this aspect as I encouraged him to share his story. He was in the Philippines and was diagnosed with pneumonia but that wasn't the worst part. It was how he was treated that shocked us. People in the Philippines were aware that he was from Hong Kong and instantly assumed he had COVID-19. Although he wasn't diagnosed with Coronavirus, he still faced discrimination by being treated like a patient of COVID-19. The staff stayed away as far as possible and he eventually ended up all alone. Therefore, my mom tried to fly out to see him. However, due to the bans and extreme COVID-19 measures, her flight kept getting postponed. Eventually she made it to him and took care of him. It was the hardest challenge he went through in this journey and he had no support from the people in our home country all because of this pandemic. In this case, it has led people to avoid each other instead of helping one another.

I believe the Coronavirus came to the world for a reason. It is a blessed curse that has destroyed so many things in life yet the hidden purpose is to open our eyes on our constant mistakes as humans often normalize negative things like pollution, racism and inequality. It's a good thing that everyone is in lockdown or on pause if you will, it gives time for the world to heal itself and reflect on our mistakes. A time like this shows how the virus is driving people insane to the point that they may go against each other instead of working together to fight it. It's truly sad to expect this from our world but we can still change that. Our fate and the answer to the question "Will COVID-19 ever end?" is all in the control of our hands. Just like Henry Ford once said, "If everyone is moving forward together, then success takes care of itself". I hope people can put their differences aside and focus on what's important and how we can benefit the world in the future, so this pandemic can end in demise.


It might be painful at first, and you might contemplate on giving up sometimes, but it will all be worth it. I thank Linda, and myself, for encouraging me to carry on with my journey.
