

2022.01.18 Latest Diocesan Pastoral Measures Applied to RHS Chapel

According to the Latest Diocesan Pastoral Measures issued on Jan 18, 2022, Rosaryhill School Chapel is to apply it in such ways below, with immediate effect and until further notice:

1. The “Suspension” of ‘Public Masses’ and of ‘other face-to-face religious gatherings’ is to remain in force.
2. Sunday Catechism classes are to remain through Zoom meeting.
3. The Chapel is open for private prayer and visit of the Blessed Sacrament, and
4. Provides giving Holy Communion for the faithful’s spiritual benefits at 10:30 am, Sunday, and all visitors should observe these guidelines and measures:
 - a. properly disposed by either attending a Mass online or paying a visit to the Blessed Sacrament beforehand;
 - b. Before entering the school compound, scan the “LeaveHomeSafe” venue QR code;
 - c. Keep mask on during the stay;
 - d. Screen body temperature;
 - e. Sanitize hands;
 - f. Keep at least 1-meter social-distancing from each other
 - g. No more than 25% of the capacity of the chapel;
 - h. After the Holy Communion rite, the faithful should not continue gathering together.
